CHARTS/POWERS:

- Airplay is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase: 100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.
- **2 Retention** is calculated by listener Tune-In and Tune-Out using trailing 6 weeks, weighting the most recent week double, and the five weeks prior equally.
- 3 National Callout contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.
- 4 Streaming, Audio contemplates trailing 14 days of aggregated on-demand audio streams. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an X. These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **5 Streaming, Video** contemplates trailing 14 days of aggregated on-demand video streams. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an X. These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **Sales** is based on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

Note: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.



CURRENT POSITION:



There's quite a rumble around Music City about The Mulehouse! What brought you to such a bold career shift?

Interviews are far and away my favorite part of being on air — and I'd like to think that's what I do best. I like to connect fans with their favorite artists on a deeply personal and relatable level — that means it's a genuine conversation with a natural flow. The current world of PPM doesn't necessarily allow for that kind of discovery. But by building our own concert/music venue I'll be able to showcase those interviews, on stage, for both live and virtual audiences. Sometimes you have to build your own opportunity. That's what started this process just over two years ago.

You're one of the most recognizable names and voices in Radio. Does this planned launch of The Mulehouse lead to a newly conceptualized Blair Garner show?

Let's put it this way — within our 55,500 square-foot property is a new state-of-the-art radio studio. People will be surprised by what comes next.

Let's talk about the idea of mixing the live venue experience and the new online performance format. Looks like The Mulehouse will embrace both. How will that work?

Within twenty days we will formally announce the different business partners with which we've joined forces. Each is the undisputed leader in their respective fields. Each shares our one, singular and collective goal — to elevate the expectations of what a venue can offer to both artists and their fans.

You're going to be competing with some of the most legendary music venues on Earth. How do you see The Mulehouse setting itself apart?

We look to be a true business partner with the artists, their managers, and most-importantly the record labels. Album launches. Virtual radio tours. Label showcases. Everyone involved will leave with valuable content affording them any number of uses. That's where the on-stage interviews become so valuable. We want to help get those stories out to the masses. We want to forge a deeper connection between the artist and their fans. We hope to play a valuable role in the promotion of all things Country Music.

Terrestrial Radio is changing. What differences do you visualize for the Country format in the next say, 5 years?

I think radio will come to represent a convergence of different media. Your iPhone is the perfect example. The utility of a phone is now married to the convenience of a navigation system, a camera, a personal assistant, etc. The word "phone" now represents many things. Similarly, "radio" will come to represent far more than it currently does. Radio will become better adept at extending its reach through digital and visual integration. But that said, it will forever be known as 'radio'.

You've beautifully documented the conception to reality of The Mulehouse. How can Blair fans find the story of the on-line?
