In the last few years and considering recent radio restructuring, how has the relationship between labels and radio changed?

Let me start by saying I still believe that radio is the greatest way to make a song a big hit, but as more and more ways are created to bring music to the public it creates a great big pile of additional data that can be used to make decisions on new songs to play. Today's reps need to find a way to filter out the noise and come up with useable data. Of course, we need to do that for ourselves as well. Also, with the downsizing of our industry we all have more responsibilities and, frankly, less time to hang with reps which I do miss. I built some lasting relationships over the years that I treasure with people that I love talking (arguing) with about music but that's tougher now.

In your opinion, who are the greatest radio personalities of all time and why?

I'm very partial to the people I've worked with over the years. I've been lucky to work with talented people. But I grew up in New York listening to NYC radio and I still have a soft spot in my heart for Cousin Brucie, and Harry Harrison from WABC-AM, Jim Kerr, Pat St John, Carol Miller at WPLJ were so cool, Alison Steele on WNEW... just awesome. And Coyote McCloud from Y107 Nashville. When he was good, he was great and when he was bad, well, we have some great stories from those days.

There are tracks that are streaming immense numbers (in the top 10 streams) that are not necessarily label priorities for radio. Should they be considered for radio exposure?

Considered? Of course. If the public is already telling you that they love a song so you have to factor that in when you're making music decisions. It is important to try to understand WHY it's getting big streaming numbers to better understand how to use that song on the air.

You've programmed multiple formats, with major success in both Country and Top40. As listening habits change are there advantages to having pop artists collaborating with Country artists?

Well, I've had some success in pop and have handled a few other formats but I'm still a rookie in country. It's always exciting when different format artists pair up because when it works it's magic. BUT... it doesn't always work. Like any relationship, the magic isn't always there. When it does, it can create some new cume just like crossover hits. If Lady A or Maren Morris break on CHR it may bring a few people into the country tent. Y'all are welcome!

You have been in radio since you were a kid. If radio never existed, what would be the Louis Kaplan dream job?

Easiest question yet... rhythm guitar player for The Stones.
