We just looked at your tour dates - After this long year of no live music can you describe the feeling of getting back to your fans face to face?

The last year almost feels surreal and like some kind of long dream but also like it passed in a blink. I call it the great "pause" because it feels like time froze. We are now thawing out and I am so excited to get back out there and see so many familiar faces.

You recently covered and released Holly William's "The Highway" and it really hits home. Your spin turns it into a heartwrencher. Was that your intention?

I wanted to record the song seven or eight years ago when I was limited in the number of live shows I could do because of a grueling schedule doing a full time morning radio show. Every time I would hear the song on Holly's record come up on my playlist I would stop and just weep. I missed the road so much. When you can't do what your soul yearns for the focus on your purpose really comes to the surface. In this case, that song really hit home. Fast forward to 2020, and it hit home for ALL of us. Holly wrote that song many years ago and listening now it feels so foreboding.

You're leaving for a 20 night run of dates. There are three things that must be on the bus. They are absolutely necessary and borderline guilty pleasures. What are they?

Earplugs, wine, Bluetooth speaker

You spent a nice slice of time killing it on one of Country Radio's biggest radio shows. Typically, the lifestyle and clock of morning radio hosts and touring recording artists are diametrically reversed. Can you describe the adjustment?

It was tough. The schedule was the hardest part. I've worked a lot of jobs in my life from waiting tables, bartending, painting houses, retail, food delivery - but morning radio was the hardest job

I've ever done. Going from waking up to an alarm clock at 3:30am five days a week to going on stage for a club show on Saturday at 10:30pm took a toll. I wouldn't change a thing because it made me appreciate doing shows and life on the road that much more, but I wouldn't do it again either.

You've had some monster hits. What is the one Terri Clark hidden jewel that was never released? And what song from another writer do you wish you had written?

Gosh that's tough but there are two - both ballads. I have a lot of up tempo fun hits at radio but there really are deeper cuts that a lot of people never heard and wish they had. "When You Can't Help the One You Love" from the "Pain to Kill" record and the other is a song about my relationship with my Mom who we lost to cancer in 2010 called "Smile". That was on the 2012 album "Roots and Wings." I wish I had written a lot of songs including - "Let That pony Run," "Chiseled in Stone," "Time Marches On," "Everything That Glitters," "Good ole Boys Like Me." Those songs are pure poetry.

Your hero (anyone....living or not so much) is coming to your house for dinner. Who is it and what are you preparing? (Here's the catch...you actually have to be able to prepare it)

I'd make a steak for Patsy Cline any day!!!
