



There seems to be a trend towards streaming services adding personalties. This is evident particularly with Apple Radio. What does this mean for Terrestrial local morning shows...if anything?

Local morning shows should be utilizing every platform that is available to them. Content is KING and listeners will seek it out and find it wherever they can. Podcasts have never been hotter and great personalities should use podcasting as an extension of their brand. Shows that do can really take advantage of yet another platform to get listeners and advertisers aware of their brand.

You can invite anyone in the world to lunch....Monday Morning Intel is picking up the lunch tab (good luck collecting). Name the 4 people you'd invite and why. Where would you take them out to lunch?

I am a cheap date and a huge fan of good authentic Mexican food, tacos are life. I am sort of a bookworm and would love to have a meal with one of my favorite authors like Lee Child or Vince Flynn, Michael Jordan because he is the GOAT. Throw in somebody to keep it loose and funny like Kevin Hart and maybe an artist with a guitar like George Strait, who would also bring that Codigo tequila.

Who are the people that have influenced you most in your career?

First and foremost would be my dad Roger Turnbeaugh. He passed in 1989 when I was 20 and is responsible for me being in this crazy business at age 11. I wish I could share with him how different things are today; he would freak out! Gregg Cassidy - who I followed all over the country when I was on the air - taught me how to be a great talent and how to coach talent. And lastly a PD that shall remain nameless where I had the worst experience of my career. He taught me a lot about how people should be treated, coached and motivated. Just do the opposite of everything that he did.

What's the craziest promotional thing you've ever done that had a big return, or almost got you fired?

Baseball went on strike in 1994 and my radio partner at the time Boomer Barbosa and I raised money for some little league ball fields to be built. That's the good part, the bad is we raised it through donations while we sat in every single seat at Kaufman Stadium in Kansas City. That is

37,903 squats in two and a half days on hot plastic seats in the middle of summer. I never knew how bad my hands could hurt from pushing myself up to the next seat. Will not do that again.

Do you showcase or break new artists?

We honestly try as often as possible. My PD Scott Arbough from KBCO throughout the years has broke many artists at the AAA format. Nerf from KTCL has also broke a few at Alternative and on the country side we often try and get behind what we believe are the next big artist as we feature an hour everyday dedicated to what is new.

Greatest concert you've ever been to?

That is a very hard question to answer. I got to see the Rolling Stones in the Bay area do an earthquake relief show, I saw Garth play Notre Dame and the iHeart Radio Music Festival in Vegas gives you all the feels. I have been very blessed to see so many great performances, hard to pick a favorite.

Words of wisdom you would give to your younger self 20 years ago...

Time management is a real thing and it's important. Work smarter not harder.

CHARTS/POWERS:

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
