CURRENT POSITION: VICE PRESIDENT GENERAL MANAGER KRTY

The industry is stunned. Was the sale to EMF and surprise to you and the staff?

No, the process started last November and because of my role as VP/GM I have been involved with the process from the beginning. I informed the staff at various phases of the process but by the time it was public they all knew.

Educational Media Foundation (EMF) lives and broadcasts in the Christian space. Any chance they would break protocol and stay with the successful KRTY Brand? None

Is there a possibility that the station (as we know it) can continue fully operational in the digital space?

There is always that chance. Nothing has shown how powerful the brand is to our listeners than the tremendous outpouring of support on my socials and station sites. We have a number of shows including a summer of songwriters events that we will continue to promote on KRTY.com. It's possible that if a terrestrial signal does not pop up that we could offer a streaming alternative as well.

Everyone has their opinions, but as captain of the ship, what has made KRTY the industry powerhouse that it is?

Simple answer is relationships. Relationships with labels, with artists and with our own listeners. We are in Silicon Valley, the innovation capital of the world. We made a decision 15 years ago to make KRTY fit the market. New artists, new songs, new music and the most exciting events we could do around those principles. We built trust among our listeners that what we were bringing them was great, and they saw Luke Bryan, Eric Church, Taylor Swift, Lady A etc when they were brand new.

Country overall has seen a formatic slump in ratings, yet KRTY is stronger than ever. Can you give us one or two examples of strategies that bolstered ratings in tough times?

Music Discovery is the key. We need to give people a reason to listen to an old technology and that is not the same old songs they have on their own playlists. Those songs play a role in the format, but the feature is new music from both established artists and new artists with the new artists doing live shows. (obviously before the covid) Just Friday we put a Mitchell Tenpennny Show on sale for April 21 and it sold 800 tickets the first day. 20 currents a week is not music discovery. It's boring radio and listeners can discover that on their own. Our listener passion comes from us leading them to what is new and hot. Yes it is old school radio, but even more relevant in today's on demand world.

Over the years of your KRTY leadership, is there one event, moment or story that brings you the most pride?

Garth Brooks playing the Dive Bar Show in the Rodeo Club last December is the greatest moment in the history of KRTY.

You are a notoriously creative guy. Having no restrictions but the limits of your imagination, what can revitalize terrestrial Country Radio moving forward ?

Goes back to Music Discovery. Our listeners trust us, if they didn't we would not sell the first commercial. We need to make them fans of our radio station. Any radio station can do it, but it takes hard work. Before the shutdown we did 50 of our own shows a year, even more with National touring shows. I went to shows in other markets etc etc. We need fans of artists and fans of country music, but if we are fans first we can spread the enthusiasm to our listeners and they become FANS of the Radio Station. It really is quite powerful.

On behalf of the MMI /Airplay Intel family of publications (and we're sure we speak for the industry as well) we are so thankful for the contributions you and your team have brought the radio/music industry. God Bless KRTY 4ever! Thank you so much.








MAREN MORRIS - "HUMBLE QUEST"

UNDERSTANDING EACH OF THE 6 KEY COMPONENTS

Z AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/ tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

3 NATIONAL CALLOUT contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

4 STREAMING, AUDIO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

3 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone.Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
