You have an extensive mega successful career in Modern Rock, Rock Radio. Now you have a Monster Country brand with Seattle's KNUC. Is this your first run at this format? Here's a flash card. Is this Luke Combs, Luke Bryan or Carrie Underwood? No cheating.

First time in the format, but I come by it honestly since my father was in the format his entire radio career. Can't see the flashcard but I hope is Carrie Underwood.

One of the shiniest stars in your resume is a long oversight of the legendary KROQ in LA. Describe what it was like piloting that missile.

Amazing. I never thought about the impact of the station in that city until it happened. And it didn't really happen until we got very successful. And the talent we had was incredible.

The Top 10 Streaming tracks in any major market seemed to be different to the power rotations of terrestrial radio. Why is that and is there a radio format that should match these streams more than others?

While the quick answer is Pop and Hip Hop formats, those streaming numbers may be the ones that can be most inflated. So looking at it that way some of the other types of music streaming may be more reflective of what's really happening. So confusing...

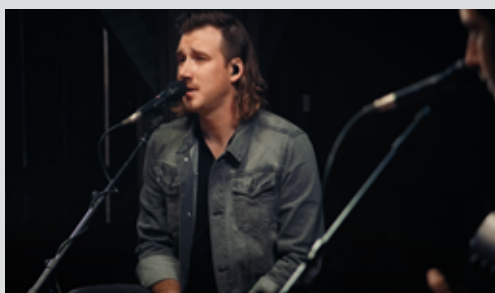

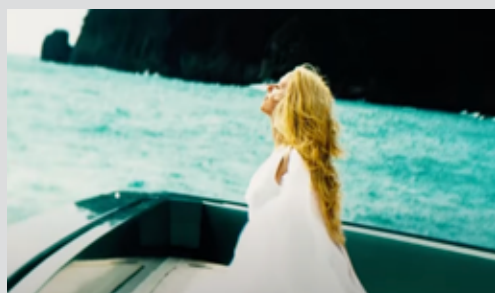
