



With talent wearing so many hats these days. Besides being the "boots on the ground" for the programming dept in a competitive Country Radio market, you're on the air in several major markets including Tampa, Milwaukee, and Nashville. How has you day changed from 5 years ago?

5 years ago...to be on the air at a radio station...you would have to drive to the radio station. I do all my shows from a home studio now. I spend a few hours a week at the station for collaboration and to work with sales team and new market manager...but everything I do in Programming is done from home studio. I always try to schedule all my meetings (real or virtual) in the morning and get all my "busy" work done by 1pm. That would be all the station business for WEZL (planning, production, music call, writing copy, etc). By 2pm, I transition to ON AIR Mode...get some prep done before I hit the air at 3pm. I do my afternoon shows on WEZL and WGTR in real time. In the 6pm hour, I begin Tracking portions of my Nights shows in McAllen, Milwaukee, and Overnights in Tampa. Since I work from a home studio...I try to check Twitter to see if anything is happening in those markets that need to be on those shows...and will pop in and update breaks throughout the night. My goal is to sound like I am there and engaged. So, I spend time...when I can...watching local newscasts online...listening to morning shows in those markets...talking with the PDs, etc. I usually wrap up around midnight (but there are breaks in the day and I can adjust my tracking schedule to suit my needs for the day)

Good Lord, there are arguments on both sides of the Morning Show debate. You have Bobby Bones in the AM and syndicated shows have access to so much. How does radio keep it local while taking advantage of national top talent?

At the end of the day, good content wins. Bobby's team is great about getting local content back to us and we make sure local news and all the service elements plus Local shoutouts, liner content, imaging is executed well during his show. Bobby is then a common thread through the rest of day on WEZL. We wanted to make sure that Bobby was a part of the station ALL Day...and not just an island. He continues to win big in Charleston. And, in my opinion, "What's Local" has changed in the last couple of years. Because of Social Media...we interact with friends all over the country. Plus...No One says that the Local CBS affiliate isn't local when they go to The Late Show at 11:30pm...because Good Content Wins!

A massive meteor is hurdling towards Earth. Mega destruction is inevitable. Luckily you built a spaceship the can house your family, one pet and 6 other people. This mission: to begin a community on Planet Zorb that's one and only business is a Country Radio station. Your 6 planet-mates must be either recording artists, radio programmers, label reps or a comedian. Who is boarding the USS Ric and why?

I think I would start with Lee Brice...great singer, he's from SC, and did some electrical work for his father's business in college. Can't start a radio station without someone who knows how to plug things in. Garth, of course, legendary country artist who has a background in construction. Billy Currington for his background in roofing. Darius Rucker...another native of Charleston...plus has renovation show on Design Network. I would probably make him the contractor to get everything built. Comedian Nate Bargatze because I am sure we would be friends in real life...and finally Lainey Wilson...because I love her, and we would need someone there to teach the rest of us Things a man ought to know.

Tell us about one book, one movie and one album we may or may not know about that we need to read/see/ hear right now?

My wife and I recently watched the Reacher series on Prime. It was great! My wife (a teacher who reads actual books) said it lined up with the books. I wouldn't know...I only read twitter.





So now, here's what we know: Young Tyra is from Kentucky, has a large and loyal female following, millions of Youtube and TikTok views, and has a voice that can stop you on your trip to Kroger, make you pull over and listen in awe. CHARTS/POWERS:

- **AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.
- 2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.
- **NATIONAL CALLOUT** contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.
- **4 STREAMING, AUDIO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **SALES** is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO. VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
