

As with the past two weeks, Zach Bryan's "Something in the Orange" continues to be one that radio is missing, in general. It ranks #1 in audio streaming, 7th in video streams and is the 7th hottest selling track yet it remains at 49th in airplay. Kane and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God" is another that is outperforming its airplay despite the buzz on the song. It's the top selling song for the second consecutive week, the 2nd highest in video streams and the 4th best in streaming audio. Even though it moved up 5 spots, "Thank God" is still ranked a low 38th in airplay.

Country's Radio Coach, Inc.

Once again, Halley Whitters and Hardy both have strong selling and streaming tunes that are lagging way behind in airplay (#47 and 35, respectively). These are the four strongest songs with the potential to see some action per our panel.

The Top 10 overall hasn't changed, apart from a move up or a down. Morgan Wallen, Luke Cobs, Cole Swindell, Tyler Hubbard, and Jelly Roll remain in that order in the top 5. Looks like Jelly Roll is definitely for real.

Bailey Zimmerman moves from 7th to 6th as airplay increases to top 10 and the song gets some legs in callout moving from 31st to 24th on top of its high ranks in streaming and sales. Thomas Rhett looks like the next top 10 candidate moving to 11th overall from 13th last week based on sales increases (20 to 16), strong callout (8th to 4th) and airplay (10 to 9).

One other to keep an eye on is Lee Brice who broke into the top 10 in sales this week at 9th and is starting to show some strength in streaming (16th in audio and 11th in video).



CURRENT POSITION: OPERATIONS MANAGER WKRO DAYTONA, FL

DEALING WITH THE AFTERMATH OF IAN

Florida took a serious wallop from Ian. Let's walk through this. And even though Daytona was on the other coast from Landfall, your city took quite a beating as well. What were the first preparations you had to make as Ian approached?

Well first and most importantly our thoughts and prayers to our everyone on Floridas west coast. It is heartbreaking to see the devastation in South West Florida. As a radio station seeing these storms heading our way we immediately make being on the air the main priority. Our engineer goes into a real mode when preparing for the storms. Power loss is almost guaranteed so making sure we have proper backups at transmitter sites and studios is crucial. And even with all that prep sometimes there are things you can't prepare for. In our case with Ivan we didn't expect the amount of water and time the storm would sit on top of us. Unfortunately we couldn't beat those elements and lost power at our locations.

In situations like this, radio becomes such an important part of getting information to the listeners. Describe the programming changes and focus before and during the storm?

I've been on air for 5 or 6 hurricanes since 2004. I can't stress enough how important radio is during hurricanes and emergencies. All of our stations switch to prep mode before a storm. You can't tell people enough how important it is to be prepared. Our news station is really the anchor for the storms. Local content is the main focus. Our music stations play music until it's time to simulcast the news stations broadcast. When we start to get through the storms music stations focus on music and updates. People are cleaning up and need to have their country music getting them through the tough times!

How about your staff? In emergencies, how do their duties change and were there any outstanding moments you'd like to mention?

Before a storm hits we make sure our staff has time to prepare their personal lives. They have families and personal property to secure. Not everyone is gonna be on-air during a storm. But everyone will be involved in providing timely and accurate information while the storm is happening. Our Dj's, sales team, and administration all live in our communities and can provide info that really helps people that are also at home. Our production director/on-air talent Paul Johnson was huge for us coming in at 10pm Wednesday evening and staying until 7am Thursday. He ran our tv affiliate and did local updates through the night leading up to storm impacting. TV was really focused on the west coast and we really focused on local impacts in our area.

Locally, what is the station doing to assist in cleanup in rebuilding for both Daytona and the rest of the effected areas?

We are provided with so much information after a hurricane hits. In Hurricane Ian's case it's been a lot of heartbreaking info about people losing their homes and actually being stuck in flooded homes unable to leave due to floods. We dissect a lot of information in a short period of time. But people want to know where they can get ice, gas, a hot meal and WHEN IS MY POWER COMING BACK ON! We try and relay as much local information as we can to our communities. On-air and through social media outlets.

What can others, such as other markets, labels and industry partners do to support the recovery?

In lan's case most of Florida was impacted by this hurricane. A lot of markets were preparing the same we were for this storm. Ian definitely created a lot of stress in peoples lives. This is my first hurricane running a country station. The overwhelming amount of check ins from reps and labels was special. Whatever labels can do to help with recovery is welcomed. So many businesses and families are gonna be impacted for long periods of time. Just being aware what radio stations are dealing with in our individual markets means a lot.

What have you learned from the experience?

It takes a couple weeks to go through everything that has happened and how we can improve. But the one constant after every hurricane I have broadcast through was the people of our community stepping up to help each other through this. Our first responders, utility teams, hospital nurses and doctors all working around the clock and through the storms to save lives is extraordinarily special. Neighbors paddling boats to rescues stranded families is beyond special. I'm gonna go to work tomorrow and be on the air. I'm never gonna take that for granted. Please continue to say prayers for everyone that was impacted by this hurricane. I think as I wrote this 81 people in Florida have lost their lives. As bad as the pictures are I know In my heart how strong Florida is!! Florida says "hold my beer" and watch how we handle this!


