

Zach Bryan "Something In The Orange" continues to be the one that radio is missing. It's the #1 audio streaming song, #2 video streamer and 7th in sales yet 49th in airplay. Kane and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God", again, is outperforming its radio airplay as the #1 selling song, 4th in video and 7th audio streaming. They are inching upward in airplay moving to 29th from 38th last week. Hardy and Lainey Wilson's "Wait In The Truck" looks more like a future hit every week ranking 4th in sales and 7th in streaming that powerful video. The song still sits at #33 in airplay but ranks 18th overall in callout. All 3 appear to have what it takes to secure some major attention from our panel.

Country's Radio Coach, Inc.

Morgan Wallen, Cole Swindell and Luke Combs are still solid 1-2-3 overall with Tyler Hubbard and Jellyroll rounding out the top 5. New to the top 10 this week are Russell Dickerson moving from 12th to 8th behind consistently good numbers across the board and Jordan Davis gets to #10 from last week's 13th based on streaming, sales and increased airplay.

Thomas Rhett looks like the next top 10 candidate with strong callout (#4) and airplay (#6) plus the sales are starting to pick as he moves into the top 15. Lee Brice "Soul" is now a consistent performer with increases in streaming and airplay.

CURRENT POSITION: WHKO DAYTON MORNING/PD

Ok let's get right down to it. We're coming to Dayton. Can you get us a table at The Pine Club?

If you have patience grasshopper! They don't take reservations, but if you get there early, the wait's not too bad. You can sit at the bar until they call. BUT, remember they don't accept credit cards so bring plenty of cash. Otherwise, you'll have to go across the street to the Sunoco and use the ATM. BUT it's worth it.

WHKO seems to have a lot of "live and local" air talent. (That includes you in AM Drive). This is a rarity in 2022. What is the secret and the idea behind it all?

Actually, we are all local. Many of us are "homers" from around this area. My morning show partner Woody and I are from the same hometown of South Charleston, Ohio and both graduated from Southeastern High School (Go Trojans!) different decades of course. We're lucky we have so much pride and support in the Miami Valley from our air staff. We're fully invested in this community and are out and about at events, from dog walks to fundraisers. It's important. We're partners with the Children's Miracle Network benefiting our Dayton Children's Hospital. At the end of this month, we'll be doing our 25th Cares for Kids Radiothon. Over all this time, listeners have donated over 5 million dollars to the hospital.

You are known in the industry as the classic mix of creativity and science. Seriously? More data is available than ever before. How do you keep your gut and original ideas in play when you're scouring thru numbers?

For me, being on the morning show is key—you still have that connection to listeners in a way a traditional PD may not. You take the calls, you're out in the public with them, so you can hear what they like/don't like/are into in person and by how they vote on our app. It's also a benefit I'm from this area—it's my home. Johnny Chiang always told me, "stay true to Dayton." Some of the best advice ever—I know this market, because I AM this market and I'm a fan of country music. I surround myself with a music team of all ages and interests. I listen to my nephews. I look at streaming, Shazam, Pandora, Spotify, in addition to traditional numbers

from Mediabase and BDS. It is a fine dance between gut and common sense in choosing music. Our listeners tell us what they want.

Did you hear about NASA slamming into a meteor on purpose? Supposed the test was real and THEY MISSED. There's a massive hunk of rock about to take Earth out of well, "power rotation".

You have the time to listen to one complete album before they 'Big Kablewee". What's it gonna be? You didn't specify which format. Country: Randy Travis "Storms of Life. Big hair band: Def Leppard "Hysteria".

Double Header Question: The best Morning show bit you ever executed and the best station promotion (either yours or someone else's) you can remember?

We used to send out our "Prize Guy to do stunts during the show---one day we told listeners they had to follow him around a local parking lot and whoever reached him first when he stopped would get free gas! They did. A can of beans. They were not happy, but it was great!! Station promotion—this has been an ongoing benchmark for us since 2012. The Second Date Update---I know others do it now, but we were one of the first---a couple goes on a date, one of them wants another, the other not so much. We get them on the phone to find out what went wrong. It never fails for this to be the number one comment from listeners in diary posts and in public. They love Second Date.

There are all these Country tracks emerging with monster numbers on the streaming services. Zach Bryan, Haily Whitters, Warren Zeiders, Cory Kent...and they seem to be moving tickets as well. How and when do these explosive tracks effect airplay consideration?

They ALWAYS get airplay consideration. We wouldn't be doing our due diligence if we didn't pay attention to those numbers—keeping in mind they're not likely our target audience---but we look for patterns. "How long have they been getting those numbers? Are we getting hit up on social media by fan club blasts?" Again, it's listening to the what the people want and using your common sense.

You have a rare quiet day off. Describe your dream "best day ever"?

Sleeping past my usual 2am alarm, walking my cat (yes on a leash) once we get up, starting the day listening to the station—as a listener—watching a rerun of "Law and Order: Criminal Intent"—salmon for dinner with asparagus in the air fryer, drinking an entire bottle of Champagne with no headache or hangover and (sorry everyone), not one call from a label.

The Mic is hot, the red light is on, the audience is ready to you to rap a sailor to your heroes. Please try to rhyme a few of em, yo.

Hey y'all it's N-Dub on the mic, shouting out some lines on what we all like, I got country on the speakers in my ride with my boo by my side, The Possum, Morgan, both Lukes and Hardy, Cranking it up, bout to have a party.

Thanks to the Man up above and those who keep us safe, remembering their sacrifice and what they gave. Love to those who tune us in, cause withoutcha how we gonna win?




ZACH BRYAN - "SOMETHING IN THE ORANGE"

CHARTS/POWERS:

Monday

MORNING

AIRPLAY is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

UNDERSTANDING EACH OF THE 6 KEY COMPONENTS

Z AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/ tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

3 NATIONAL CALLOUT contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

4 STREAMING, AUDIO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

3 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone.Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
