MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Zach Bryan's "Something In The Orange" continues to vastly outpace its airplay ranking #1 in audio streaming, #2 streaming video and 5th in Sales. All that is enough to move the song up to 18th from #20 overall despite only advancing to 46th from 48th in airplay. Most of the panel is missing what appears to be a country hit.

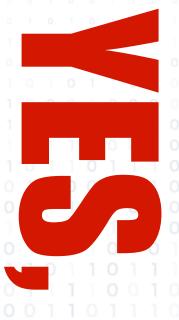
Then there's Bailey Zimmerman. First of all, his "Fall In Love" breaks into the top 5 overall ranked 7th in sales and audio streams, 4th in video streaming and a respectable 15th in callout. A SECOND cut, "Rock And A Hard Place" gets the nod for the most underexposed song this week in light of some amazing numbers – 8th in sales and 3rd in both video and audio streaming but dead last in airplay at #50. I'm guessing our panel, at some point, may face the possibility of playing two Bailey Zimmerman tunes at the same time!

Several up-and-comers getting some panel attention are Gabby Barrett going from 18th to 14th on the chart based on a solid ranking of 10th in airplay and top 20 ranks in both callout and audio streams. Jimmie Allen continues his rise into the top 15 at #15 from 19th last week. He breaks into the top 20 in sales at 18 and is appearing to be a radio audience favorite already ranking 8th in callout. Carly Pearce "What He Didn't Do" makes its move into the top 20 this week at 19th showing good numbers in audio and video streaming (15th and 11th, respectively) and a solid 14th in callout. These are 3 songs that need the panel's immediate attention, for sure.

One new entry into the top 5 is the aforementioned Bailey Zimmerman going from 7th to 5th and Jelly Roll advances to #3 overall from 5th with strong across the board numbers. Tyler Hubbard hangs in at #4 with a very impressive top 5 rank on callout. Still on top at 1 and 2 are Morgan Wallen and Cole Swindell. Cole appears to have some amazing staying power for the panel.

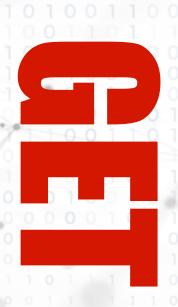

CURRENT POSITION:

NATIONAL DIRECTOR OF RADIO PROMOTION BIG LOUD

You've had successful promotion stints at Rock, Pop and now Country. With programmers absorbing more oversight and extended duties, what advice would you give programming execs who are taking over Country for the first time?

Communication...we are a passionate bunch of promo reps over here at country, and the most important thing (for me at least) is communication...and I will do the same for you. Good news or bad news, I would just like to know what's up. What's up with a potential ADD, what's up with my record(s) at your station, what's up with the show I'm bringing my artist in for. Information is key.

We see a pattern. The Uber successful Big Loud seems to have a strategy to convert successful writers into performing artists. Looking at Hardy, Ernest, Lily Rose, and Hailey Whitters, what is the genesis of this model? We have an amazing team at Big Loud from Management, to A&R, to Publishing, to Marketing, to Radio Promotion, and everyone else in the building. We also have really close and trusting relationships with our writers & artists. Teamwork, and thorough communication across the board is a big key to our success. But I've got to give major credit to our Publishing Dept, our A&R dept, and our management dept. They have the ability to discovery talent before others do. They have an ear and an eye for star power and are able to take that talent and push these writers/artists to be the best they can be.

You are the captain of a rowing team that has to win a race along the Cumberland River starting in Nashville and ending in Williamsburg, Kentucky. The goal: winning. Your row-mates are are a PD, an Artist, a non-Big Loud promo rep, and a songwriter. Who are they and why?

For the PD, I'm recruiting Meg Stevens (PD WUBL/Atlanta). She takes rowing classes for fitness, and she's a force to be reckoned with. I'd do anything for Meg, and I trust her to help our team win! For the Artist, I'm taking Jimmie Allen. The dude is ripped! He will for sure be the muscle on this boat, but even more important for this rowing journey, he's absolutely hilarious! If you're hanging out with me, we're going to have fun and were going to laugh.

Jimmie makes me laugh every time I'm around him and he's a bad ass and 100% the best dressed everywhere he goes, and we want to look good as we cross that finish line! For the Non BLR Promo Rep, that's an easy choice. I'm choosing my good friend Stephanie Hagerty (National Dir., Radio for Warner WEA). She's an athlete (played college basketball) and back to my previous comment about having fun on this boat, she's so dang funny and a joy to hang out with. For the songwriter, I'm taking my dude HARDY. He's a lyrical genius, he's a friend to everyone he meets, he'll have Busch Light beer on him in case we get thirsty, and he has the ability to take out any wildlife that may get in our way on our race to the finish line.

You're walking into a programmer's office and you only have one tool from which to extract from your bag of tricks. Would you choose:

- A. 50 million streams?
- B. A song so good that it can knock you off your chair?
- C. Favorable call-out from 15 other markets?
- D. Your extremely good looks and charm?

...Programmers may question streams and research stories. Looks and charm can be subjective. So this is an easy answer, B. A Song so good that it can knock you off your chair. For me, it's all about the song! I'll never forget what my father, Butch Waugh, told me regarding radio Promotion as he was leading successful record labels and promotion teams... he said to me, speaking from the point of view of a Promotion Rep, "You're only as good as the song you're working." If you don't have the song, you're not going to get the radio airplay needed to secure a "hit". It has to always be about the song first and foremost. You can use a lot of smoke & mirrors to make a song appear great, but if it's not truly great, it'll never last.

You're sitting down and writing a letter to your 18 year old self. What advice do you have for a young Tyler?

Oh man, I've been reflecting on my past a lot lately, so this question is top of mind for me. First, I would tell myself to not waste my money on material items. Instead, invest that money for your future, and use that money to create experiences which will create memories. Instead of buying motorcycles, expensive clothing, and going out every single night to restaurants and to bars until they closed for the night, I wish I used that time and money to travel and explore this beautiful world. I wish I spent time traveling around the US, and more time traveling around the world experiencing all the amazing adventures, and people, and cultures out there. And to my previous statement about not spending all my money drinking at clubs and bars every night, I'd tell myself to not get so caught up in the party scene. Yeah, it's fun, but once you're older and look back, you'll realize nothing much came from it other than headaches and drama. Lastly, and most importantly, I'd tell myself to spend more time on Self Care and Personal Health. Life is so short and it goes by so fast. The healthier you are mentally and physically, the more you'll enjoy each wonderful day.

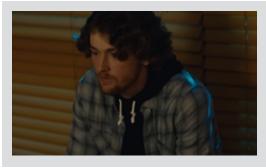
HAILEY WHITTERS - "PLAIN JANE" (ACOUSTIC)

CHARTS/POWERS:

- **AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.
- 2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.
- **NATIONAL CALLOUT** contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.
- **4 STREAMING, AUDIO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **SALES** is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
