MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Two songs approaching "red hot" status after only three weeks of life!! English singer-songwriter, Pink Pantheress and her "Boy's A Liar", moves up 5 spots into the top 15 at #15 on the overall chart this week with a strong story on the streaming side ranked 5th in video and 2nd in audio. Meanwhile, California-born actor/songwriter/singer, Miguel with "Sure Thing", hits the top 10 for the first time this week moving from 13 to 10. Streaming AND callout are driving this one ranking 7th in video streams, 9th for audio streaming and 7th in callout. Both are getting more attention from the panel with Pink Pantheress rising to 25th from 27 in airplay and Miguel is up to 23rd from #26. More stations are seeing the hit potential of these two.

Another making some steady moves over the past several weeks is Chris Brown's "Under The Influence" getting to #13 from 15th last week. With 19 weeks already under its belt, it seems to be a listener favorite in callout ranking 9th and Top 20 in streaming. Still some life left in it for sure.

One more that appears to be in crossover territory is Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" remaining at 17th overall but, after only three weeks, the song is the #1 seller and 4th in audio streaming. With an airplay rank of 30th from #34, the panel is starting to show some real interest in this one.

There's a new entry into the top 5 with Rema and Selena Gomez's "Calm Down" reaching #5 this week from 7 last week overall. It's top 5 seller ranked 4th and 4th in video streaming. Another with some longevity with 17 weeks and the panel appears to be starting to really get behind it. Dropping to 4th but still going strong after 27 weeks is "Unholy" from Sam Smith and Kim Petras. Ranking Top 5 in sales and callout and top 10 with video streams, the song refuses to die. Remaining in the #3 position is "Kill Bill" from SZA with strong numbers in streaming (3rd in both) and callout (8th). The fact that it's only been around for 9 weeks tells you how hot the song has become in such a short time. Talk about refusing to die, the biggest mover of the week is a song that's been around for 28 weeks!! The Weekend's "Die For You" has surged in streaming and sales, being the top-ranked audio streamer of the week and up to #3 in sales. In addition, ranking 5th in callout tells the panel that this is an across-the-board smash that will not go away. Heavy this one up as much as possible.

For the second consecutive week, Miley Cyrus' "Flowers" is number one on the overall chart ranking top 5 in all 4 categories including being the top video streamer. At just 8 weeks old, this shows that the panel jumped on the bandwagon quickly and it's paying off.

The big five for the week ... Sia "Unstoppable", Metro Boomin' "Creepin'", The Kid Laroï with Justin Bieber "Stay", Miley Cyrus with "Flowers" and then we hit a clump of re-currents for #5. There are several songs that continue to test well with both sides of the demo. The headline to me is that Sia's song continues to be a monster hit. Miley's "Flowers" continues to show growth. The song is #1 in the South. I'm told that she has a new song on the way. We've not seen this type of music profile from Ms. Cyrus since her launch. Love it and the format can use it.

The biggest burning song is "Levitation" by Dua Lipa. It's only at 15% burn. It's not until a 20% burn level that you need to think about extinguishing the fire in a song. Songs with double digit burn on this weeks research include "Unstoppable" by Sia, "Stay" by The Kid Laroï & Justin Bieber, "Bad Habits" Ed Sheeran, Nicky You're "Sunroof", Sam Smith & Kim Petras "Unholy", the duo of David Guetta and Bebe Rexha with "I'm Good", Meghan Trainor "Made You Look" and Harry Styles "As It Was." One to add to that list is "Cuff It" by Beyoncé.

Taylor Swift's song "Anti Hero" has a good solid base on which to build. It's performing well with women 25-32 and 33-39. Same can be said for The Weeknd "Die for You." The songs performs better older, but shows little burn and high familiarity. It's a unique male voice on a chart that's loaded with females ... at this moment. "Victoria's Secret" by Jax is the latest high profile "ear worm" of a song. Being a Girl Dad, I'm appreciative of the lyrics as it deals with body issues in a light hearted, but poignant way.

When it comes to "Twin Spins" (Google the reference) artists with two on the chart include Taylor Swift, Pink, Harry Styles and SZA. If we include SZA's feature on Lizzo's song "Special (Remix)" she has a hat trick. (Hockey fans will understand that). Taylor's tunes "Anti Hero" and "Lavender Haze" look to be around for a long time given the acceptance of these two songs in the research.

The most impressive song this week, based on the research we're seeing, is Parmelee's "Take My Name." The country crossover has done well with females in multiple formats. It's testing Top-16 overall, but slightly better with Women 33-39. The balance of the song, combined with the positive scores we're seeing, means this song can provide some nice diversity when scheduling music. It's a strong song.

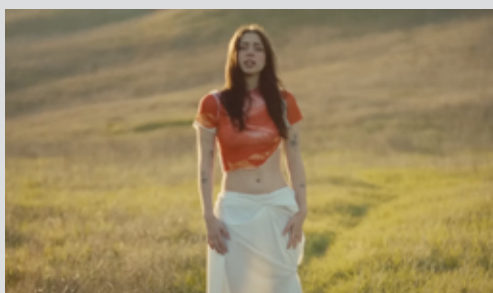

6 SALES is based on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
