First it was Miley Cyrus about 7 weeks back. Now, there are two more who are taking off like a shot after just 3 weeks on the Mediabase Chart. Miguel's "Sure Thing" is looking more and more like just that (a sure thing!!) rising to 8th on the Powers chart from 10 last week. Top 10 in audio streams and callout and top 5 in video streams, more stations jumped on the bandwagon as the airplay rises five positions to #18. The British Tik Tok phenom, Pink Pantheress and "Boy's A Liar", is within one spot of the top 10 moving up to #11 from 15th overall last week. With callout picking up at 18th, it's a streaming and sales monster ranking 2nd in sales and audio streams and 3rd in video streams. More panel believers jumping on board with airplay now at #22 from 25th last week. The reaction has been so quick and strong to both, that the panel will need to move just as quick on them. Don't miss out on two songs the listeners are feeling now.

Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" continues to exhibit impressive crossover potential advancing 3 spots to #14 overall this week. It's the #2 seller and the top audio streamer but still has some room to move up in callout. More stations are taking the chance as the airplay rank is up to 24th from 30 last week. He's nowhere near the household name he has for country, but this young man is making it known that he could be a multi-format star. The panel should put any preconceived notions aside and just look at the numbers.

Get ready for two more "newbies" that could start making some noise from two very opposite sides of the musical spectrum. Metro Boomin' may have another possible hit with "Superhero (Heroes and Villains)" featuring Chris Brown and Future. It's already a top 10 streamer ranking 8th in video and 9th in audio. The panel is still all over "Creepin" as this one is low at #48 in airplay. Alternative rocker and Philly native, Lizzy McAlpine, is making some noise on the pop side after going top 10 on the rock chart. Her haunting tune "Ceilings" is 9th in video streams and 16th on the audio side but, more importantly, she starts ranked at 42nd in airplay. Pretty high for a song like this. Some of the panel is on board early.

The top 5 just won't budge. Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" stays at #5 overall. It's a big seller ranked 3rd and the video hits the 6th spot in streaming. "Unholy" from Sam Smith and Kim Petras holds at 4th on the strength of top 5 in callout and top 10 in sales. The Weekend's "Die For You" drops one spot to 3rd but still is a streaming giant ranking 3rd in audio streams and 4th in callout. A definite listener preference even after 29 weeks! SZA's "Kill Bill" checks in at #2 from 3rd last week. It's a top 5 streamer and 7th in callout giving the panel a clearcut reason to put or keep that in heavy. Once again at #1 is "Flowers" from Miley Cyrus. This is a total smash ranking #1 in sales, 2nd in video streams and callout and 5th in audio streams. With only 9 weeks on the chart, this has a lot more growth left in it.

We have a new leading song for the week. The big five are ... Metro Boomin' "Creepin'" becomes the highest testing song. Miley and "Flowers" is number two. In the three position is The Kid Laroi with Justin Bieber "Stay" and at number four is Sia with "Unstoppable." Then we hit a clump of re-currents at number five leading off with Ed Sheeran "Bad Habits." Glass Animals is at number six with "Heat Waves." Sheeran has two titles in the Top-10 as "Shivers" comes in as the seventh best testing song for the week.

There are several songs that continue to test well with both sides of the demo. Ms. Cyrus' song "Flowers" continues to show growth. The song is #1 in the Midwest and the South. This song was predicted by this research process to be highly accepted. Joining it as songs showing real potential are Meghan Trainor "Made You Look", Coi Leray "Players" looks like it's for real as it posts a promising store on the upper end of the female sample. Also looking like it will grow quickly is the song by Sam Smith "I'm Not Here to Make Friends."

Given that all things are cyclical, watch for a shake-up in a couple weeks as we're starting to see double digit burn on songs by Sia, Glass Animals, Sam Smith f/Kim Petras, Dua Lipa, David Guetta & Bebe Rexha, Nicky Youre, Lizzo, Stephen Sanchez and Beyonce. None of these tunes are crispy. The growing burn does suggest that those on the top of the chart, that have been testing for a significant period of time, can be shifted to recurrent.

The most impressive song this week, based on the research we're seeing, is the aforementioned song by Coi Leray. Bloody Mary by Lady Gaga is showing positive acceptance with the Top-40 research panel. Given that songs cross from Top-40 to Hot AC as a part of their lifecycle, it is reasonable to expect that this song will; show eventual growth with this panel. The song is already showing a good "Total Like" score for a song that's only been on the active chart a short time. Because of its' history, it is a familiar song.

Want to freshen-up your playlist? "Blind for Love" by the American Authors, Jason Mraz "I Feel Like Dancing", Mimi Webb "Red Flags" and For King and Country "Love Me Like I Am" are new entries or recent entries into the test sample. These titles have upside potential, but need more familiarity. These four tunes are worthy of exposure at night, overnights, and weekends to build familiarity that they can be evaluated with more of a foundation under them.
