MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

JOHN SHOMBY Owner/CEO

Wouldn't it be nice to be Morgan Wallen these days? Number one artist in the format. Fills up an arena in Nashville for a free show announced just two days earlier. Sells out arenas everywhere. Releases a 36-cut album that is already getting amazing attention after just a week. The best example of all of this is our Power chart. Morgan, with three songs, showing up in the top 30 (all from the new album) is now one of those artists you cannot play enough. First and foremost, the song dedicated to his mother, "Thought You Should Know" STILL sits at the top spot on the chart. It's the number one callout and top 5 in sales and streaming. The other two cuts are making progress in different ways. "One Thing At A Time", which is apparently the next single, remains at #27 on the chart BUT it's 10th in sales and 8th in streaming PLUS the panel is getting more interested as the airplay rises to 38th from #45 last week. Then there's "Last Night", which is crossing over to pop, by the way. This one jumps from 17th to #10 overall as the #1 seller and streamer and at #6 in callout. There may be a challenge for the new single if this keeps up. If it's me, I'd play all 3. You can't go wrong with this artist right now!


Another "newbie" making some noise is Jordan Davis with "The Next Thing You Know". After only two weeks, it rises to #18 from 26 last week based on a #9 rank in video streams and 8th in callout. The song is one of those that hits right at the heart, but it still remains to be seen if this type of success continues. The panel is showing more interest as the airplay rank moves up to 42nd from 47 last week.

The top 5 is comprised of the same songs but in different places. Kane and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God" is still going strong at #5 down two spots from last week with top 5 numbers in sales and streaming. Lainey Wilson's "Heart Like A Truck" hangs in at #4 again this week holding in the top 5 in sales and callout and top 10 in streaming. Dropping one place to #3 this week is "Rock and a Hard Place" from Bailey Zimmerman ranking top 5 in audio streams and callout. Luke Combs "Going Gone" makes a nice jump to 2nd from 5th last week. Top 10 in sales and streaming and 3rd in callout, it keeps Luke right on the heels of Morgan who, as mentioned earlier, is still in the top spot.

I can't not end this without mentioning Zach Bryan's "Something In The Orange" down one spot to 14th this week but STILL 2nd in streaming and 6th in sales. The airplay rank inches up to 28th from 29 last week but the panel is still skeptical for some strange reason.





APD/MD/ON AIR 98.7 THE BULL (KUPL) PORTLAND, OR

Portland has branded itself as "weird". What's so weird about it and (with that said) what's the story with the Shanghai tunnels? Man Portland is WEIRD, we have so many different types of people in Portland, We have the Famous Uni Piper who rolls around the city wearing a Darth Vader Mask on a unicycle while he plays the Bagpipes that shoot flames he's famous, We have the Most Strip Clubs per capita then anywhere else in the country, we have roughly 2500 coffee shops in PDX, we also have the World's Smallest Park recognized by the Guinness Book of Records, The Yearly Naked Bike Ride and of course the Shangai Tunnels that run under the City of Roses, If you have never been to PDX and are planning a trip it is a must to check out Old Town Pizza & Brewing AKA The Merchant Hotel that was built in 1880 that sits above the infamous tunnels below the historic downtown district and is reportedly one of the most haunted places in Portland. that's just some of the stuff that makes portland weird.

So you definitely program in an eclectic city. When programming music how do you reflect that and not rely on the same airplay charts that also serve unique sub-cultured cities like Houston and Miami?

We have such a diverse group of listeners in our demo, we have a massive LGBTQ community in the PNW that loves country music and we are proud to support them and their love for country music, we also have a huge amount of listeners who live the lifestyle on the outskirts and are country to the core. We are fortunate to be able to play what we want and not be handed down a corporate mandate list of songs to play. When it comes time to music we look at a few different scenarios, we take into consideration and look heavily and the consumption numbers and reports, what is happening on the charts, along with the DSP research that we can see, and a lot of the time, our music is on point with what we are seeing. Portlanders want and are asking for a variety of music, if you look at the Luminate streaming numbers in Portland today you'd see Portlanders are streaming John Denver, Johnny Cash, Zach Bryan, and artist we have not played in a long time and new artists who are on the rise. Which is cool. Being the midday host I hear from a lot of listeners who are hearing music elsewhere and are asking me to play new artists such as Zach Bryan, Warren Zeiders, and even Cody Jinks so it's my reresponsibility to share it with my fellow co-workers and our PD to listen and see how we can merge the two to lead the charge and win, We definitely like to think outside the box, we did it with Walker Hayes (Fancy Like), in the beginning, we were one of the first stations in the country to Jump on after we saw those streaming numbers take off, and we said if we wait? we miss the bus! If we jump we're first in line for the celebration so we jumped and road that rocket to the moon and celebrated.

In most major markets, the top 10 streaming tracks and the top 10 most played singles at terrestrial Country Radio are quite different. Will they ever grow together? If so or if not....why?

I don't think the Top 10 songs will ever match, They may come close let's say 5 out of 10 will match up occasionally, but I don't think they will ever grow together or consistently match up. Now if you're just chasing streams and building your playlist off that alone then that's a different story obviously. This week, Nationally Morgan Wallen's Last Night is sitting at 24+/- million Streams followed by Lil Nas X on the national streaming numbers, We are on Morgan giving our listeners what they want, Lil Nas X is no longer in our rotation, we were on it when It was a moment like we are seeing now with Morgan. So No I don't think they will.. That's my opinion, others may argue and say things differently.

Your nose dive from a rooftop is legendary. Smashed up your pretty face, broke a full slab of ribs, and more. How the heck did that happen and are you full-tilt ok now?

Before I was in radio growing up in So Cal, I was a handyman working construction, Roofing, and Tile Work, I love to work with my hands on projects that I know I could tackle. On July 4th, 2020 I decided to build an outdoor party

patio 30x15 with an outdoor fire pit. Sitting area and place to play country music with friends and family. I Was putting up rafters for the roof up 12 ft high when I accidentally stepped on a wrong 2x6 that counter livered and hit me in the face busting me open and forcing me to jump Like The Ultimate Warrior in the WWE landing head first in the hard concrete below. Busting 11 of 12 ribs, my collar bone in two places, puncturing my lung in two places, and dislocating 6 vertebraes in my back. I was in ICU for 11 days on a Breathing machine lucky to be alive and the doctors said I definitely had guardian angels on my side. I do have PTSD, I can't watch videos of people crashing that you would see on Funniest Home Videos, Yeah not so funny I remember the sound and feeling so vividly! so I no longer climb on ladders over 3 feet tall and walk a little slower these days. Overall I'm tender in the ribs and have a 7-inch rod in my shoulder that I'm learning to live with, I'm good I can still play golf with my kids and I'm able to walk and enjoy life with my wife thanks for asking.

From Television to radio, your resume is quite diverse and chocked full of cool stops. Looking at how our biz is rapidly changing and besides the one, you have now, use your famous imagination and tell us a story of "Danny's Dream Job".

Being able to do TV and Radio together has always been a blessing, I was thrown into TV while doing mornings at KUPL, As part of a five-person morning show, I was the Man On The Street with Lee & Susan And The Waking crew. Our local Fox affiliate whom we worked with at the time said they need a p/t traffic reporter to fly around the city from time to time you know anyone? The next thing I know I'm in a helicopter buzzing the Rose City and spent the next 17 years there and then jumped to our ABC affiliate for another 4 years, it definitely is a blast to work with both local Stations. I think my Ultimate dream job would be to follow the steps of Ralph Emery, Crook, And Chase, and Seacrest, having a radio show and a talk show like Ellen where I could combine the two worlds together and make it fun and entertaining, I think that would be great, Did Somone say that James Corden is calling it Quits...

What is your favorite Salmon recipe and can you make it or just order it off the menu?

Man I love a good Spring Chinook Salmon and the yearly run is underway now in the PNW. With so many friends as guides, I've learned a few of their favorite recipes over the years My favorite way to cook up a huge slab of salmon is very simple and basic it's Danny's Crabbed Stuffed Salmon and it's amazing we cook it in the Smoker on a cedar wood plank for 2 ½ hours. Friends and family love it. And you can probably find the same style recipe on Pinterest, if you really want mine let me know and I''ll share it with ya. I very rarely order off the menu.

What are your thoughts on DSPs having live personalities? Is that challenging traditional radio shows? Or do they play to a different audience?

Personally, I think it would work for the younger generation and play to a different audience that is always on the go! as we all know you get 8-10 seconds to make an impact and keep them tuned in, it's easy to ask your smart speaker to play your favorite artist/Song and she or it can reply as we have heard. Spotify has announced that AI DJs can help pick and play your music which sounds weird by the way and we also heard that Amazon Music was in the beta program and giving this a try. I have yet to hear it and it does make me wonder what is coming. We now hear all the chatter that AI is going to make its way in and make some noise, and we now know this is going be a Seminar Subect at CRS This week and I have a feeling that room is gonna packed. It definitely has people on edge. Some may embrace it and others may not. Being at KUPL/987 The Bull for the past 25 years has been incredible and over the years we have built some amazing relationships with clients, listeners and we have become like family members, watching families expand, kids grow and loved one's pass, I don't think you'll get that true genuine feeling from a DSP Jock or AI Voice that our listeners and have come custom too. It's definitely is going to be challenging and interesting to see how this plays out.

Name 5 people (living or not currently using oxygen) that have made radio great.

Growing Up In So Cal as a kid we had a tidepool of personalities...The Real Don Steele, Casey Kasem, Charlie Tuna, Rick Dees, Mark, and Brian the talent was insane. With that said I'm thankful to Rick Dees & Mark & Brian for making it clear on what I wanted to do In Life they made radio fun. I have had the opportunity to work with so many great personalities over the years at KZLA & KUPL there are too many to list but a few names that really stick out to me that made great radio are Shawn Parr and The Late Country Radio Hall Of Famer Lee Rogers, they both brought something special to the format I Love, they both gave me a shot and believed in me. They had big personalities, were genuine and caring, and captured the hearts of listeners.

What is one thing you've learned,...one nugget of wisdom...personally or professionally, for which you are grateful that you can share with others?

Over the past 30+ years in Country Music, I've learned some valuable lessons, Lee Rogers always told us to Shake Hands, Kiss Babies and Be Kind. A life lesson from my grandparents was to treat people the way you want to be treated and be respectful and caring. In Today's society we never know what people are going thru or dealing with, So with those little nuggets of wisdom, I try to greet everyone with a hug or a smile, I Like to make my own sunshine and try to share the Vitamin D with others to put a smile on there face to help them get thru their daily routine.

CHARTS/POWERS:

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
