MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Not a lot of movement this week which gives an indication that the music out there is staying with the audience for a while. Three 4-point upward moves this week top the list of the best. Philly native, bedroom pop Tik Tok star, Lizzy McAlpine breaks into the top 20 at #20 from 24th last week. Top 15 numbers in video streaming and callout gets her rolling along with a #16 rank in audio streams. With her airplay rank rising three spots to 34th, this haunting tune could have a future at CHR. The panel should stay attentive.

Taylor Swift's "Lavender Haze" moves up to 14th from #18 after 21 weeks on the Mediabase chart. The strength of the song is in sales (#12), audio streams (14th) and callout (17th). Callout champ "Creepin'" from Metro Boomin' with help from The Weekend and 21 Savage enters the top 5 Power chart for the first time at #4 up from 8th. Not only is it the #1 callout tune but it also ranks 8th in sales and audio streams solidifying this as a BIG hit!

Something else to keep an eye on just below the top 25 is Female rapper Big Boss Vette's "Pretty Girls Walk" making it up to 26th from 31. Top 15 sales and top 20 video streaming and callout, this reaction song has lots of time, and room, for this one to continue to develop.

Looking really like an actual country crossover, "Last Night" from Morgan Wallen hangs at 11th this week and it's still the #1 audio streamed song plus 3rd in sales and 18th in callout. With an airplay rank staying at 24, there are still some who may be a tad cautious about playing this.

Another fast mover after 6 weeks is Pink Pantheress' "Boy's a Liar" moving up one position to 8th overall behind some strong streaming numbers – 1st in video and 2nd in audio – plus a respectable 12th in callout. A reaction song really making its mark quickly.

The top 5 is the same other than Metro Boomin' entry at 4th. The Weekend's "Die For You" remains in the 5th spot ranking top 5 in audio streams and callout plus top 10 in sales. Still strong after 31 weeks on the chart. Hanging in at 3rd is "Calm Down" from Rema and Selena Gomez behind top 5 sales numbers and top 10 in streaming and callout. It's taken a little time (20 weeks) but this one is now a solid hit. Holding at #2 is "Kill Bill" from SZA ranking 3rd in audio streams and 4th in callout and top 10 sales and video streams. For the 5th straight, Miley Cyrus owns the top spot on the chart powered by #2 ranks in sales and video streams, 4th in audio streaming and 3rd in callout. This one will definitely be around a while longer.

One to keep an eye on, especially as her tour hits more cities, is Taylor Swift's "All of the Girls You've Loved". It debuts at 19 on the Power chart being the top seller and #6 audio streamer. Long way to go but Taylor songs have a tendency to take hold and stick for a long time.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

It took every ounce of my conscience to avoid opening this weeks Callout Diagnosis with an Aprils Fools joke. During my time in the Program Director chair, I have pulled a few pranks on the music industry by numbering every song #1 or suddenly having my reported list change format. None of those April 1st shenanigans. This report is based on research across the four regions of the United States and measures the acceptance of songs with radio listeners.

Lizzo, Miley, Metro Boomin', Sia, Sam Smith f/Kim Petras, Jax and Meghan Trainor continue to show strength. Showing up as the ones to focus on as future Powers are Parmalee "Say My name", Lewis Capaldi with "Forget Me", "Players" from Coi Leray and "Die for You" by Weeknd. These titles are showing familiarity, positive acceptance and low burn/tired of scores. The logjam of Recurrents on many lists can start to slow down in favor of fresher well testing titles.

The Hot AC format is building into a Superstar format for the summer. Taylor Swift is developing a strong story with the song "Anti-Hero." Testing slightly better with upper demo females (33-39) versus lower demo females (25-32). Harry Styles is right there with her and "Late Night Talking."

Lizzo's song "Special (Remix)", which features SZA, is at the 32nd best testing song. Speaking of the artist with the three-letter name, SZA (s i z e / SIZ-e) has "Kill Bill" as the 30th highest researching tune. The St. Louis native also has a song another title which is just getting started. That one is titled "Nobody Gets Me." None of her three songs test below 50% Total Positive. Not ready for higher rotations but all three, including the one where Lizzo is the lead artist, are showing signs of a heavier rotation in their future.

Those titles starting to show burn include Lizzo "It's About Damn Time", "As It Was" by Harry Styles, "That's What I Want" Lil Nas X, David Guetta & Bebe Rexha with "I'm Good (Blue)", Nicky You're "Sunroof", and Dua Lipa "Levitating." Note that even though these titles have double digit burn, none of them are near 15%. There's still reason to continue to play these titles and watch for 15%+ before considering slowing them down.

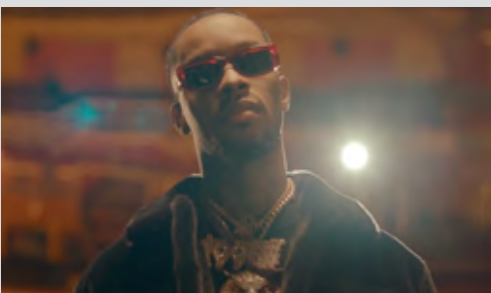

CHARTS/POWERS:

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is based on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
