MMI **WEEK AT A** **GLANCE**

After only two weeks of exposure, Rapper Toosii's melodic "Favorite Song" grabs the biggest move of the week on the Powers chart going from 23 to 14. It's solid across the board for as early as it is. 10th in sales, 9th video streaming and 6th with audio streams, the fact that it's already 24th in callout is pretty impressive. In addition, the airplay goes from 40 to 34 showing more of the panel taking a shot with this one.

The second strongest mover is Nicki Minaj's "Red Ruby Da Sleeze" breaking into the top 20 at 19th overall from 25 last week. She's the 6th top seller, 12th in callout and top 20 in audio streams. Stations appear a bit cautious with this one right now with an airplay rank of 40. Definitely an add consideration in the next few weeks.

Getting some quick attention, especially from the panel, is Ed Sheeren's newest "Eyes Closed". It debuts at 17 overall behind a strong sales week ranking 3rd and 16th in audio streams. More impressive is the airplay rank of 15 already. A good part of the panel is already hitting this one.

Bedroom Pop artist, Lizzy McAlpine, is showing her song "Ceilings" is for real, hanging in at #20 this week bolstered by sitting at #11 in video streams and 11th in callout PLUS and increase in airplay rank from 34 to 30. The panel is paying more attention for the balance possibilities I'm sure this song presents.

I believe it's safe to say that Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" has crossed over as it lands in the top 10 for the time moving up one position from last week. It's a huge seller ranked 2nd and it's the top audio streamed song this week along with a top 20 rank in callout. More stations are jumping on board as the airplay rank rises to 21st. Another one getting more love from the panel is "Boy's A Liar" from Pink Pantheress. The song remains at 8th overall on the chart with strong streaming and callout numbers – 1st in video and 3rd in audio streams plus 9th in callout. The airplay rank moves up to 12th so it's safe to say the panel believes.

One new entry into the top 5. Miguel's second time around shot with "Sure Thing" jumps to 4th from #7 last week. 7th in video streams, 10th in audio streaming and a strong 4th in callout, the panel is bringing it home as the airplay is now up to 8th. Staying at #5 after 32 weeks is The Weekend's "Die For You" with streaming and callout driving this one still. Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" hangs in at #3 with top 5 ranks in sales and video streams and top 10 with audio streaming and callout. At a very solid #2 is "Kill Bill" from SZA with top 5 audio streaming and callout numbers. The #1 song, now for the 6th straight week, is Miley Cyrus' "Flowers" ranking top 5 across the board. Only negative I'm starting to see is 16% burn especially with females 25-34 so the panel needs to keep a close eye on the rotation of this in the next few weeks.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

This week's research shows some nice growth for some of the format's image artists and introduces a couple that I believe should be the backbone of the format in the future. This format has long been a part of the lifecycle of a pop song as it moves from Contemporary Hit Radio to Hot AC and then to Adult Contemporary. The benefit of Hot AC is that the format can play the biggest hits from CHR, the most mass appeal songs from Rhythmic and those Country songs that crossover to pop. It also has the ability to embrace crossover songs from the Contemporary Christian Format. We see that in this week's research results.

Strong songs from CHR include great test scores for Miley Cyrus, Sia, Ed Sheeran and Dua Lipa. Rhythmic songs include music by Metro Boomin', Lizzo, and SZA. Country crossovers are showing great strength for Morgan Wallen and Parmalee. The CCM format is represented with music on the rise from Lauren Daigle and from For King and Country f/Jordin Sparks. All this to say that the Hot AC format is at a point where it can be considered the melting pot of music.

"Creepin'" by Metro Boomin' continues to be the highest testing and best researching song in the nation. It is only in the Midwest where it drops from #1 to #5. Miley Cyrus continues to be a strong song across the nation scoring the #2 position. It is Miley that bumped Metro Boomin' out of the #1 spot in the Midwest where she tops the charts. Neither song has significant burn with Ms. Cyrus just now entering the double-digit range and the song "Creepin'" showing high single digits. These songs continue to research as worthy of the Power Category.

Despite some stations moving "Unholy" by Sam Smith and Kim Petras to Recurrent, the song continues to show a score that should keep the song in a Power category. I understand the need to move titles along to allow for there to be room for new music, but this one has a 67.7 Positive with only a 10.4 burn score nationally. It's a strong #2 in the Northeast, #10 in the Midwest, #7 in the South and #11 in the West. All this to say that it has legs to continue in Power for another week or two.

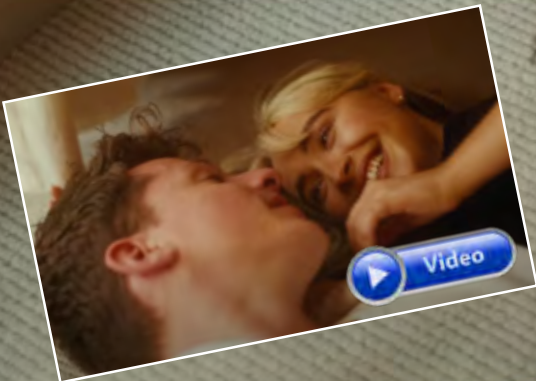

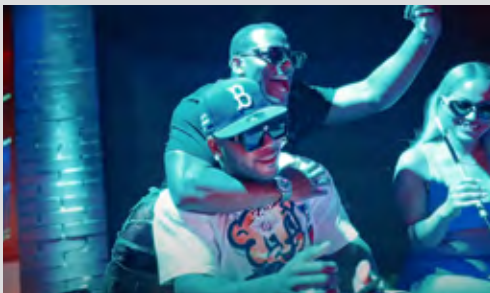

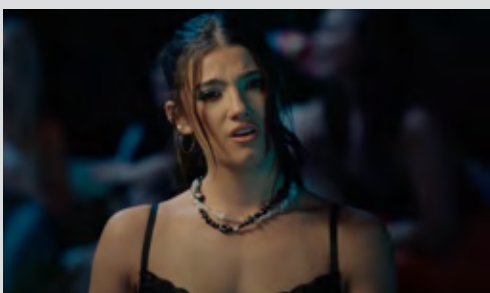

CHARTS/POWERS:

1 AIRPLAY is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

3 NATIONAL CALLOUT contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

4 STREAMING, AUDIO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
