MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Having another big week on a chart where the biggest mover rose 3 slots, Toosi's melodic "Favorite Song" is now at #12 from 14 last week. It's a top 10 seller and streamer and has just hit the top 20 in callout after in only its 3rd week. The panel is showing increased interest in this as the airplay rank now sits at 25 up 9 spots from last week. Keep a VERY close eye on this one. Another panel early discovery is Meghan Trainor's follow-up to "Made You Look" called "Mother" ranking 21st in airplay after just 5 weeks. This throwback sound has gotten immediate reaction as a top 5 video streamer and top 20 in sales ranking 18th on the overall chart up 3 from a week ago.

Taylor Swift just keeps on cranking them out. Finally, after 23 weeks on Mediabase, her "Lavender Haze" enters the top 10 on the overall Powers chart showing strength as a top 10 seller and top 15 with audio streams and callout. Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" is convincing new panel members each week this is a crossover hit going 21 to 19 in airplay rank. Overall, the song moves up one spot to #9 as the #1 seller and audio streamer and top 15 in callout. Ed Sheeren's "Eyes Closed" is showing its no fluke rising to 16 from 17 last week. The strength is in sales ranking 6th and airplay going from 15th to 12th. Looking for callout and streams to catch up soon but, regardless, Ed is a radio favorite, and it shows with this one.

Pink Pantheress' "Boy's A Liar" going into its 9th week already reaches 6th overall after being at 8 last week. She's the #1 video streamer, 3rd in audio streams and all the way up to 9th in callout. Those numbers indicate a clear fan favorite, and the panel is agreeing moving 12th to 11th in airplay. I see a definite rotation increase here.

The top 5 has not changed from last week. Still, after 33 weeks, The Weekend's "Die For You" has lots of life remaining at #5 behind top 5 audio streaming and callout. Miguel's "Sure Thing", back for an encore after a few years, hangs in at 4th as a top 5 callout and top 10 streamer. This has flown up the chart in only 8 weeks' time and with an airplay rank at 8, the panel is following suit. Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" is still making noise at #3 ranking top 5 in sales and video streams and top 10 in audio streams and callout. Took the song a little while but it finally appears to be coming home. "Kill Bill" from SZA stays in the second spot with top 5 numbers in sales and video streams and top 10 in callout and audio streaming. For the 7th consecutive week, "Flowers" by Miley Cyrus holds on to number one ranking top 5 across the board.

One to keep an eye on after only 4 weeks is "Ceilings" from bedroom pop artist, Lizzy McAlpine. It's up one to 19 on the overall chart but it's starting to pick up traction in callout (13th) and audio streams (16th) and the airplay rank has risen from 32 to 27. As I mentioned last week, this is one of those good tunes to consider for balance.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

There are no new titles added to the list of positive testing titles this week, but the strong songs continue to be those recorded by Miley Cyrus, Sia, Ed Sheeran and Dua Lipa. Crushing it are Metro Boomin', Lizzo, and SZA. Morgan Wallen and Parmalee continue as those that have crossed from the Country format. Lauren Daigle and For King and Country f/Jordin Sparks show strong growth crossing from the Contemporary Christian Music format. The value of a crossover is that it becomes more familiar more quickly and that means you either succeed solidly or fail fast. I'm not seeing any "fail" on any of the crossover artists.

Sia is back up to the #1 overall best testing song. Only 10.3% Burn on the song. It's in reality a recurrent, but it's so strong that it warrants remaining a Power or putting it into the Recurrent category with a 50% Back rule so it comes up more frequently. "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin' continues to be one of the highest testing and best researching song in the nation. Miley Cyrus's song "Flowers" is showing growth with familiarity. These songs continue to research as worthy of the Power Category.

Morgan Wallen's song "Last Night" is interesting to me. Great growth pushes it to #20 as it becomes more familiar. Despite many thinking of him as a contemporary artist who sounds country, he's testing stronger with the upper end of the female cell. That is to say that with women 33-39 he looks like he's headed to the Power category in a couple weeks. Not quite as strong with women 25-32, but still out scores many artists whose names are synonymous with pop.

Start looking for fun, up-tempo, energetic songs for summer. This is the time of year to be ready to launch an ear worm over Memorial Day Weekend that will be strong for the summer. 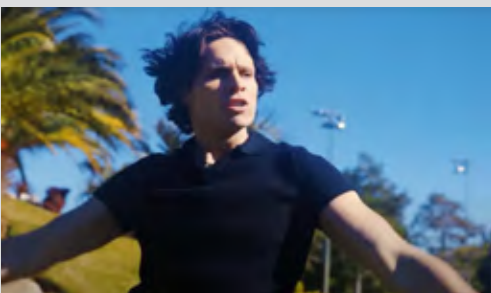
JONAS BROTHERS - "WAFFLE HOUSE" LIVE ON SNL

CHARTS/POWERS:

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
