MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

After just two weeks, Post Malone has blasted his way onto the Powers chart debuting at #12 overall. Ranking 4th in sales and 9th in audio streams, the airplay rank already at 12 shows how much the panel is already into it. These could be the CHR summer hit for 2023. Sure is shaping up that way so far.

More stations are getting behind two country crossover hits. Kane and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God" makes into the top 15 in airplay (at 15) for the first time. At #10 in sales, 20 in audio streams and 18th in callout, it's looking very solid at this point. Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" jumps ahead of Kane at 14th in airplay from 16 last week. That, coupled with top ranks in sales and audio streams places the song in the overall top 5 at 4th. Morgan has a CHR hit!

Toosi's melodic "Favorite Song" is gaining stations after only 4 weeks rising to 19th in airplay while still bringing in top 10 numbers in sales and streaming. The callout picture is also improving, getting up to 21, so it's time for the panel to get serious about this one.

The hottest of the hot this week are about the same as the past several weeks. Miguel's "Sure Thing" ranks 5th overall behind a big move up to 2nd in callout. Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" is still making noise at #3 overall with top 10 numbers in sales, streaming and callout. SZA's "Kill Bill" continues to tear it up as the 2nd ranked song overall on the Powers chart. Top 5 callout and audio streams lead the way along with top 10 ranks in sales and video streams. 16 weeks in, this is not showing any signs of letting up. With her biggest hit in quite some time, Miley Cyrus "Flowers" remains the top-ranked tune overall reaching top 5 in all categories. One thing to note, though, is the fact the song is getting to the point of high burn so be very careful with how long this hangs in heavy.

Several new ones to watch. Another from the country crossover bin, which is apparently growing, is Luke Combs "Fast Car". Whoever thought he might have one crossover to pop! This remake of the 80's Tracy Chapman smash may be just that. The song debuts at 16 on the overall chart ranking top 5 in sales and audio streams and already 16th in callout. With airplay at 41st, there is still a long way for the song to go before the panel believes but it's off to a good start.

Drake's new one "Search and Rescue" enters the overall chart at 15th just from audio streams (3rd) and early callout (9th) alone. Like Luke Combs, it's still very early with an airplay rank at #44 but something for the panel to watch closely given Drake's track record.

The big hits keep on proving why they're the big hits. The top six songs all have 70+ scores and only two of them have double digit burn. Those are "I'm Good (Blue)" by David Guetta and Bebe Rexha along with Sia and "Unstoppable." The Aussie with the former #1 song remains at #2 in the Northeast and Midwest and is #4 Nationally. The onetime character voice on both Scooby Doo and South Park is enjoying one of her biggest hits of all time. It still tests strong enough for the Power category, although some stations have begun moving it into Recurrent.

The rest of the Chart Toppers are Metro Boomin', The Kid Laroï & Justin Bieber, David Guetta and Bebe Rexha, Sia, Sam Smith with Kim Petras and Glass Animals. Before you start whining about the number of 25+ week songs at the top of the research report ... We have some new songs on the scene this week. "Chemical" by Post Malone, "Jaded" is the new one by Miley Cyrus and "Mine" by Kelly Clarkson brings the daytime variety show leader back to music and sets her up for radio airplay.

The Crispy Critters include "Levitating" by Dua Lipa and "As t Was" by Harry Styles. To be fair, those two have the most burn on the chart and that's only an identical 13.3 for both songs. That's a low burn score and certainly playable on-going as a current based on the score. However, some movement on titles growing in familiarity, provides an opportunity to freshen-up your playlist. Coi Leray's song "Players", "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen, the song "River" by Miley Cyrus and Jax new song "Cinderella Snapped" are all tracks starting to grow on the positive side. Slow growth, but with familiarity these scores will show growth.

The jury is still out on what the Song of Summer 2023 will be, but Coi Leray's "Players" could be it. In the category of what's old is new again ... Coi Leray is also part of a mix created by David Guetta and Anne-Marie. "Baby Don't Hurt Me" is the song and it reflects a "today" version of the song originally recorded in 1993 by Haddaway. Guetta's mix mastery is excellent and the song is an ear worm. It could be the one for this summer as it's already a Top-10 researching song with the CHR panel.

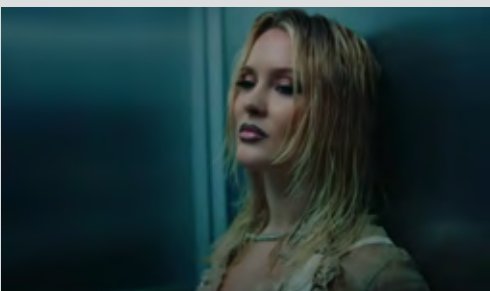
RITA ORA FT. FAT BOY SLIM - "PRAISING YOU"

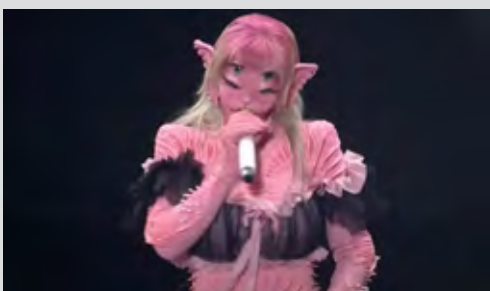

CHARTS/POWERS:

1 AIRPLAY is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

3 NATIONAL CALLOUT contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

4 STREAMING, AUDIO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is based on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
