



MMI WEEK AT A **GLANCE**


Not a lot of big movers this week but there are some tunes showing that they are here to stay and some, as the Brothers Osborne once sang, to "stay a little longer". Morgan Wallen has a double again this week with the title cut from the album and single, "One Thing at A Time", moving up one spot to 13th overall. Sales and streaming is behind it ranking 8th in video and 5th in audio streams and 11th in sales. The "non-single", "Last Night", solidifies its top 5 ranking rising one position to 4th. It's the top seller, top streamer, and 5th in callout. "Thing" leads the airplay race up to 14th this week while last night increases its position to 21st. More and more of the panel are deciding to play both. Do it!!!


Luke Combs boasts having 3 cuts on the chart. "Going Going Gone" stays in the top 5 at 5th. It's top 10 in sales and video streaming and 2nd in callout. Still strong enough to be in heavy. Meanwhile, two other cuts from the just released "Gettin' Old" album are getting some attention. "Love You Anyway" is 7th in video streaming and 2nd in audio streams but dead last in airplay rank while "5-Leaf Clover" is 7th in sales and 4th in audio streaming and 48th in airplay. Some of the panel featured cuts in its release week last week and have, since, backed off. Waiting to see what the new single will be.


Jordan Davis' "Next Thing You Know" is starting to pick up adds rising to 23rd from #28 in airplay this week. Streaming is the song's strength ranking 6th in video and 7th in audio streams. Corey Kent's "Wild As Her" gets to its highest power chart position this week going from 9th to 7th. Top 10 ranks in video streaming and callout are the story here and the airplay position at #9 shows the panel is behind it. Then there's Carly Pearce's "What He Didn't Do". Two weeks after reaching number one and then dropping out of the top 10 on the Mediabase chart, this song is still doing the job remaining at #6 on the power chart based on top 10 numbers in sales, audio streams and callout. Too bad some of the panel plays the chart game as the song drops all the way to 13th from #3 in airplay. If it's me, I'm keeping this in heavy for a little while longer.

The top 5 is relatively the same except for some position changes. I've already mentioned #5 (Luke Combs) and #4 (Morgan Wallen). Rising one spot to 3rd is Hardy and Lainey Wilson's "wait in the truck", a clear hit ranking 3rd in sales, 2nd with the powerful CMT Award-winning video and top 10 in audio streams and callout. With another one in the top 5 this week, CMT and CMA award winning Lainey Wilson stays at #2 with "Heart Like a Truck". It's the #2 seller, 5th in video streaming (an award winner), 8th in audio streams and 7th in callout. The only thing keeping her from heading back to #1 is Bailey Zimmerman's "Rock and a Hard Place" now #1 for the 3rd straight week. #4 in sales, 3rd in video streams, 6th in audio streams and the #1 callout tune, this one looks as if it will be up here for a bit longer. Getting ready to jump in as the next one for Bailey is the title cut from his forthcoming album (May 12th), "Religiously". The song debuts at 36 on the Power chart. It's already top 20 (16th) in audio streams so the panel should be ready.

CURRENT POSITION:

ARTISTS/SINGER-SONGWRITER VALORY MUSIC CO.

Tell us a story about, as a Nashville kid, the one day or night that you and your buddies did something cool, crazy which you probably got in trouble. Be bold....we won't tell. Only friends here.

I was 18, I had just graduated high school and my dream was always to have a motorcycle. A couple of my buddies had some, and so the day I had I signed my record deal I drove to the dealership and bought my own. This was my parents biggest nightmare, so I drove it to my friends house and hid it in his garage. A couple days later my Dad found the receipt, and it wasn't a good day in the smith household.

Last year's EP "Didn't Go Too Far" contained the viral hit "I Hate Alabama". Millions of new fans discovered you when the discovered the song. Even though it had a sweet romantic twist, many saw it as a dig at the Crimson Tide. Did you get flack from the rabid football fans down Tuscaloosa way?

As I write this, the last show we played (5 days ago) was actually in Tuscaloosa. The venue sold out and every single person in there sang "I Hate Alabama" with me. That to me was always the beauty of this song. It is a backhanded compliment to the school. They beat my team in football every year, and they stole my girl, who wouldn't want to be them.

What is the most personal song that you have written that contains a message or lesson that affected you deeply?

I wrote a song at 14 years old called, Jesus and Me. This song was about my great grand parents love story, and the day I played it for my parents my mom told me that one day I would play it at the Grand Ole Opry. When the day came I got to make my Opry debut, without telling my family, I surprised them, and made my moms words come true. It was the most special moment of my career, and one that will forever mean so much to my family.

Many of your songs are co-writes, which is THE Nashville standard. But...what if the state of Tennessee moved to outlaw co-writes. How would 'Conner only' compositions effect your sound, lyrics and style of composing?

This is something I do a lot. On my debut album, I am sure there will be plenty examples of songs written solely by me. It is something I take pride in. I love sitting down with a guitar and challenging myself to write songs with only my words. Those songs usually hold a very honest mirror up to wherever I am in life in that moment.

You have a rare day off in your Hometown of Nashville. Derrick Henry, Tim Roberts and Shakira want you to show them around town including a lunch and dinner stop, some sight-seeing and an off-the-beaten path secret favorite location. What is your itinerary?

First off, that is an incredible crew. For lunch I am taking them to this butchery west of town called Bare Bones Butchery. Best cheeseburger in town. After that we are getting out of town. I would take our crew 40 minutes south to the prettiest place in all of Tennessee, "Liepers Fork." We would sit around the fire out side Puckett's restaurant and have dinner to some country band playing on the same stage that I got my start play at when I was 7 years old.

From any decade, any writer and any genre...what is the most perfect song ever written?

Just to see you smile will always get me. It's all about the second verse, "I told you that I was happy for you, and given the chance I'd lie again... Just to see you smile."

Or "there goes my life" - Kenny Cheney. Everything that is great about country music.

If your music could send a message to change one thing in this world, what would that be?

Life is short. Focus on what matters
