

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



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MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Jellyroll has a second big week! Although snubbed by the ACM's, the storytelling singer appears to be on his way with a another big hit in "Need A Favor". In three weeks' time, the song has gone from 17th to 12th to 8th this week. Its story is no doubt an integral reason for being the #2 seller, 6th in video streaming and 8th in callout. More of the panel are jumping in as the airplay rank rises from 28 to 24. Still a lot of the panel left. This is a reaction song that should considered sooner rather than later.

Luke Combs is now matching Morgan Wallen with multiple songs on the Power chart. The new single "Love You Anyway" makes its way into the top 20 right at #20 from 25 last week. It's too early for any callout info but the song is streaming strong – 8th with video and 5th with audio. Luke's fans chose this as the new single, but the panel is still running a bit behind with an airplay rank down at 46. The other big cut from Luke's new album "Gettin' Old", "5 Leaf Cover" rolls back one spot to 22 this week but it is streaming well also at #7 in audio streams. The panel slightly has favored this one with the airplay rank at 39. Seeing the adds on both this week, it should be interesting to see what song wins the actual airplay battle.

With Morgan Wallen, it is clearly "Last Night" now the #2 song on the overall power chart. It's number one in sales and streaming and 3rd in callout. Total smash here. Meanwhile, the single and album title cut "One Thing At A Time" moves up one position to 12th overall. It's still in decent shape at #10 in sales, 9th with video streams and 4th in audio streams. Ranking 40th in callout does show which one is the listeners' choice. The panel slightly favors "Last" which is 13th (from 19) in airplay while "One Thing" is right behind at 14. If it's me, I'm playing the two Morgan cuts and the two Luke tunes.

Making a surprise two position move up to 13 is our old friend Zach Bryan and "Something In The Orange". In its 27th week, the song is still a big seller ranked 6th and an all-star streamer at 2nd in both. Callout (38) and airplay (29) ranks are still stalled so I have to say the panel continues to miss this one.

The top 5 has the same songs but a couple in different spots. Tyler Hubbard's "Dancin' In The Country" stays at #5. Top 10 in sales and streams, the song is a callout giant ranking 2nd. Lainey Wilson and Morgan Wallen trade spots. "Heart Like A Truck" moves back to 4th but hangs in as a top 5 seller, video streamer and callout and 8th in audio streams. With 47 weeks under its belt, the song still has plenty of juice. Lainey's collab with Hardy "Wait In The Truck" remains at #3 driven by that powerful video ranking 4th and sales at #4 plus 7th in callout. This one's been around for 33 weeks.

Earlier we mentioned Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" at #2 and, once again, for week #5, "Rock and a Hard Place" from Bailey Zimmerman is number one. 3rd in streaming, 5th in sales and #1 in callout. Keep hammering away at this one and the rest of the top 5.





CURRENT POSITION:

HOST OF KATIE & COMPANY AUDACY | COUNTRY

First and biggest question — How the heck did you get from tracking overnights in Bloomington, Illinois to middays in New York City to being the syndicated midday country air personality on 20-plus (I know I got this wrong!) stations? And what's it like working for all those PD's now?

Well, long story short. I was tracking overnights at WBNQ after college when Cumulus made the decision to syndicate Perez Hilton & Adam Bomb. I was out of gig but the local Market Manager, Red Pitcher, really wanted to help me get a job. I was 22 and broke with a mountain of student loans headed my way so I decided the smart thing to do would be to change gears and pursue a job in Radio Sales. I applied for an AE position in New York City with 95.5 WPLJ and, with Red's help, got the job! The production director at Cumulus New York knew I had been on the air previously and would have me cut spots for PLJ when they needed a female voice. Which is how John Foxx found me. He heard those spots and came down to my cubicle in the sales department, we've been pals ever since. It took a few years but eventually Foxx got me a weekend shift on WNSH. I was working six, sometimes seven days a week for a year. Monday - Friday in the sales pit. Weekends in the studio. Until 2016 when I got the chance to audition for the full time Midday Job. Which would later lead to syndication within the Audacy Network and now with USRN. When I say it was a wild few years, I mean it. Ha!

As for answering to all those PDs, at first it was a lot to get used to. But over the last three years I've been able to spend me with everyone, get to know them, get to know the markets. I love working with all of them and I hope they say the same!

Word is you are a legend at Illinois State University now down as an Outstanding Alum. You also got your start at the campus station, WZND. What, in heaven's name, gave you the idea to go headfirst into this business?

Ha! I don't know about legend but they have been very gracious to honor me with a spot in their Broadcast Hall of Fame. I say, without a doubt I never would have found my way to radio without ISU and ZND. I was originally a TV Production major who needed one radio class to graduate. I remember being so terrified of having to listen to my own voice my goal was to make it through the entire semester without having to spend a single second on the mic. That didn't happen. I fell in love with it and by my senior year was hos ng the student morning show and introductory radio course.

Your syndicated show has suddenly been picked up by an international major market. If you were to make a wish as to what that city would be, tell us where and why?

London! I have very English roots and also spent a semester abroad in the UK. I know that my British friends would get such a kick out of that.

It's always apparent that you enjoy every minute of what you do. What about this job do you like the most?

Connecting with people. I really enjoy writing the show everyday and coming up with content that I think will speak to listeners, I always have fun putting my own spin on things. The interviews are a close second, I really see that as an art form and I'm always trying to get better.

The show is titled Katie and Company. Can you give us the lowdown on the "and Company"?

The "and Company" would be country ar sts who we feature daily on the Superstar Power Hour and, of course, the listeners. I've always wanted listening to the show to feel as comfortable and casual as hanging out in someone's living room, like when you have company over. I'm also hopeful that one day as the show grows we'll cast some more characters in this rodeo.

What on-air personalities have been an influence on your career?

Oh my gosh, Kidd Kraddick was my favorite radio personality growing up. I loved listening to that show on my way to school. I remember being out with friends at a bar when he passed, I had to leave and go home. That wrecked me!

Bonus question: We hear that you and your fiancé are ordained ministers. Any plans to officiate your own wedding? Have you officiated any others?

Yes we both are! I officiated my best friend's wedding in June of 2021 and Shane just did his friends wedding a few weeks ago. We won't be marrying ourselves, I feel enough pressure just writing my own vows, Iol. We've recruited Shane's best friend for that job.



CHARTS/POWERS:

- **AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.
- 2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.
- **NATIONAL CALLOUT** contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.
- **4 STREAMING, AUDIO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.
- **SALES** is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
