MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Get ready for another candidate for song of the summer which, by the way, SOUNDS like summer. With seven weeks under their belt, the Jonas Brothers enter the top 20 (#20) from 28 last week with the totally poppy "Waffle House". Sales has been immediate cracking the top 15 at 13th but the rest of the story is just beginning except the fact that the panel has already embraced it as the airplay rank rises from 15 to 12 this week. With Miley Cyrus' "Flowers" showing 21% burn despite another week at number one, her newest entry "Jaded" makes a big move this week from 36 all the way to 22 registering top 20 sales and top 25 callout. It's still early with only five weeks on the chart but this is another one the panel has gotten into early as the airplay rank goes from 22 to 19. Tells me that stations are really looking to the pop stars to get this format rolling for the summer.

The country crossovers continue to pick up some steam. Kane and Katelyn Brown's "Thank God" moves up one to 13 with top 10 sales and top 15 callout plus 14th in airplay. Luke Combs "Fast Car", the cover of that Tracey Chapman late 80's hit, inches to #11 ranking 2nd in sales, 4th in audio streaming and 9th in callout. The jury is still out as far as actual airplay is concerned moving up just two spots to 32nd. Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" remains in the top 5 at 3rd overall as the number one seller and audio streamer plus 8th with video streams and 5th in callout. With all of that, the airplay still hasn't caught up ranking 10th up from 12th. No leaps and bounds with airplay with any of the three but enough to raise an eyebrow or two.

K-Pop female group, Fifty Fifty, shows they are no flash in the pan rising one spot to #12 this week as the number one video streamer and 3rd in audio streams. Airplay lags a bit but continues to increase going from 29 to 25. Callout also is nowhere near the top 20 but, with only two weeks of chart time, it's still too early for some of the panel.

The Weeknd's "Die For You", after 39 weeks, still has plenty of life moving BACK up one spot to #6 with very impressive streaming numbers and ranking 2nd in callout. Stations are nowhere near the point of slowing it down with an airplay rank staying at 6th this week.

No big surprises although you should keep an eye on SZA's newest "Snooze" which gets to 18th from #20 last week. Streaming is driving this song at 16 with video and 12th for audio. Airplay is slowly coming around rising from 31 to 28 but, remember that "Kill Bill" is very much alive at 5th overall and top 5 airplay.

Harry Styles "As It Was" still dominates recurrent play. The only song entering the top 10 is Justin Bieber's "Ghost". With Taylor Swift having two in the top 10 ("Anti-Hero" and "Lavender Haze") along with David Guetta/Bebe Rexha, Sam Smith and Glass Animals, stations are trying to get that pop sound back into the format through this rotation.

My favorite colors ... Red, White and Blue for Memorial Day Weekend. Summer is officially underway ... even if not according to the calendared seasons. Summer is here and so are some fun, up-tempo songs. Sia and "Unstoppable" continues as one of the best testing songs available. David Guetta & Bebe Rexha and "I'm Blue" is a dominating earworm of a song. "Made You Look" by Meghan Trainor is another that has tempo and is testing playable. Her unique sound and style makes this song jump out of the speakers.

The songs that are showing Burn and warrant a slowdown in rotation, or a move to recurrent, include "Unholy" by Sam Smith & Kim Petras, "Sunroof" by Nicky Youre, The Kid Laroi & Justin Bieber "Stay", Harry Styles "As It Was" and Lizzo "About Damn Time." Interestingly, Meghan Trainor's song "Mother" is showing a Burn score of 15.0 ... which is interesting as the song is ranked at #42 on the National chart. Meaning that there's something there raising audible eyebrows on this song.

Metro Boomin' "Creepin'" is #1 in the Midwest and South. Glass Animals song "Heat Waves" is #1 in the Northeast. The #1 song in the West is "Bad Habits" by Ed Sheeran. Looking at songs with potential, believing that a geographic imbalance signals one to watch as a projected hit, includes "Calm Down" by Rema & Selena Gomez. That song is #9 in the Northeast with the West coming in next at #16. Posted at #8 in the Northeast is Taylor Swift and the song "Anti-Hero." That song is being powered everywhere, but it's now showing the research to support the rotation.

Continuing with an analysis of geographic regions ... Coi Leray "Players" is #3 in the South. Showing in the high teens otherwise. Morgan Wallen is Top-10 in the South showing up at #6 in the south. Which makes sense as the song is more familiar in markets and regions where country radio shows its' greatest audience strength. A song showing strong as a predicted hit and destined for the Power category is "Sure Thing" by Miguel.

Intriguing to me is "Fast Car" by Luke Combs. It's a cover of the 1988 Tracy Chapman hit song. What intrigues me about it is that Luke recorded it with the exact same perspective, which is that of a woman. It doesn't change the fact that it's an immediately familiar song and starting to test well, but it is a unique approach. This is Combs first real crossover to pop. The song is testing the best in the Western region coming in at #14. Welcome to summer. Crank it up!

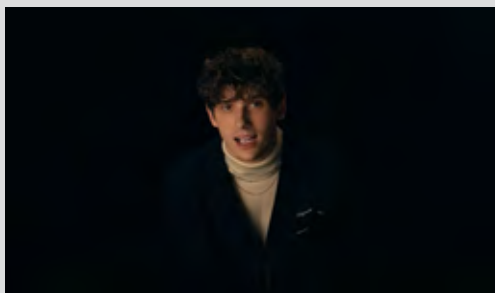

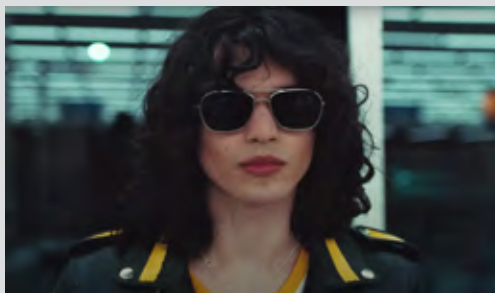
MAROON 5 - "MIDDLE GROUND"

CHARTS/POWERS:

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
