


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

Once again, the two biggest artists in the format have three songs each in the top 25 on this week's Powers chart. Luke Combs is still in a building stage with all three of his. Two of the album cuts – "Fast Car and "Five Leaf Clover" are steady at this point. "Five" stays at 24 this week with top 20 numbers in sales and video streams and top 15 in audio streaming. With the airplay rank descending to 48 from 44, it appears most of the panel is going to concentrate on the single while "Fast" moves up 3 spots to make it to #20. It's a number two seller and audio streamer and 7th in video streams. The airplay rank with this one is up to 44th from 49 with still a long way to go. The actual single "Love You Anyway" is off to a reasonable start dropping just three spots in its second week to 14. Still developing on the callout side, the song ranks top 10 in audio streaming and top 12 in sales and video streams. The surprising stat is the airplay going from 31 to 28. A lot of this would have to be because each station on the panel has several his past hit songs in some rotation.

Morgan Wallen looks as if he's taking over the #1 artist spot from Luke just from the performance of his music over the past few months. The single "One Thing at a Time" moves up one slot to #11 this week ranking top 10 in sales and streaming, and up to 9th in airplay. The callout story is mediocre at this point. One new album cut "Thinkin' About You" is starting to raise its hand as it hangs at #19 for a second straight week. Already a top 5 seller and streamer, this is one for the panel to watch closely. Meanwhile, the OTHER album cut "Last Night" has reached number one moving up one spot from last week. Number one in sales and streaming and number two in callout, it's now closing in on the top 5 in airplay rank at #6. Safe to say this is the hit and the panel knows it. You can't play this enough right now. Actually, you can't play Morgan enough right now.

Jellyroll stays on the move rising to 7th from 9 last week. "Need A Favor" ranks 3rd in sales, 8th in video streams, 13th in audio streaming and 12th in callout. The airplay rank remains at 20 so the panel is still not playing it too often with plenty of time to develop after only 14 weeks.

The rest of the top 4 is familiar. Parker McCollum's "Handle On You" stays at #5 as a top 10 audio streamer while Hardy and Lainey Wilson's "Wait In The Truck" slides to 4th from 3rd. The song is top 5 sales, video stream and callout. Airplay is dropping going to 15th from 6th showing that some of the panel got on this one way early and the time has come for them. Up one to #3 is "Dancin' in the Country" from Tyler Hubbard. Top 5 callout and top 10 in audio streaming and sales, at 20 weeks the song has lots of life left. Bailey Zimmerman's "Rock and a Hard Place" finally, after 6 weeks, relinquishes the top spot dropping to #2 but remains the #1 for callout and top 5 in streaming. This top 5 is still solid for most as your heavy rotation.

CURRENT POSITION: PROGRAM DIRECTOR WXBQ BRISTOL, JOHNSON CITY, KINGSPORT, TN

Ok, let's start with an easy one. Take this pill, close your eyes and imagine this: Playing recorded music on terrestrial radio has become illegal in all 50 states, punishable by 25 year sentence of incarceration with no parole. You have 24 hours of programming to fill. What are you going to do?

Run sports radio and fill out job apps.

## There's a rumor that you used to play in an actual touring Bluegrass band. True or false? If true, tell us a story from the road and how did the experience effect your programming philosophy?

Very true. I was held prisoner of war by a family of O.C.D. musicians that forced me to stand and play music for hours at a time. At first, they just threw me into guitar cases and let me sleep as an infant. Later, they had girlfriends of random musicians babysit me while they were on stage. They taught me to play when I was five years old and by the time I was eleven or twelve they had me playing shows and doing session work. They were traveling musicians, so a lot of times I found myself in places where there were no familiar faces. It taught me how to start random conversations and make friends with strangers. (Basically everything normal kids are warned against.)

It also taught me to pay attention to how crowds respond to different levels of showmanship and storytelling. Bluegrass is very stripped down and raw. You can't really hide behind distortion. Once you get a crowd, you have to be on your toes and make sure it's right or you'll lose them for good. Playing the songs they want to hear and making the most of every possible opportunity to connect on a personal level with the audience is crucial to an individual performance and in building a loyal following.

#### Let's first established that Country music has a wider appeal and now reaches (Thank God) a younger and hipper demo. With that said, Boy Bands and Girl Bands have always been HUGE across the hall at Pop Radio. And now, K-Pop is globally massive and consist mainly of Boy/Girl groups. Why has the phenomenon never taken a deeper root in Country?

The closest thing we've had to a boy band was probably Rascal Flatts in 2002?

Country is a very reality based format. I think country fans are looking for stories and relatable themes. They're not ashamed to embrace family, community, core values and just being "real". Pop has always leaned toward self-centered escapism to me. The way relationships, work and life goals are viewed

and expressed is very "singular" and self absorbed. That's not a slam by any means. It's just where they are at that moment in their lives. By the time new listeners migrate to country or find it relatable...it's not so much about the "dreamy" aspects or escapist view of what life "could be"... it's about what life really is and how they're navigating through things. That's an oversimplified, yet convoluted, answer.

Also...I don't really think anyone wants to see choreographed dancers in matching outfits doing any line dances to "Family Tradition" or "Wait In The Truck".

## We failed geography. Which is it Bristol, Tennesee or Virginia? And describe a perfect day in your home town and it's ok to criss-cross over state lines!

It's both! State Street runs down the main street in Bristol. Tennessee is on one side of the street and Virginia is on the other. If you're looking for legal weed, the Hard Rock Casino and lower sales tax, in theory...Virginia is the place to be. If you're looking for NASCAR, good tattoo shops and Panda Express...Tennessee is for you. The best things about both: the awesome people, live music and being able to find that on either side of the road on any given evening.

## WXBQ and your Steve, Ben and Nikki Morning Show have a mantle filled with metal deluxe. Over the years the ACM and CMA awards have been plentiful.. What makes WXBQ so successful?

Our very own Hall of Famer's Bill Hagy and the late owner "Mr. Pete" Nininger worked so well together to lay the groundwork and build the WXBQ brand. It's always been community and music first around here. Mr. Pete's daughter Lisa and her husband Roger Bouldin make this a great place to work. They treat all of us like family and our audience is a priority. We're also extremely blessed to have an incredibly talented air staff at XBQ. Marcus Brooks, Tragler, Drake and Reggie are staples in the Tri Cities.These guys are great on the air and in person. Steve Stroud is also a super talented writer and performer. Ben has been around major market radio for years and learned so much from Rusty Walker. We have a lot of fun doing our shows. With a foundation like that, it's easy to focus on what needs to be done for the community.

Becky Brenner is a badass. Ginny Brophey, Meg Stevens, Sue Wilson, Lisa McKay, Beverly Brannigan, Heather Froglear and of course, Whitney Allen have all paved the way for so many others.

Scott Mahalick is a broadcasting warfare expert.

Nate Deaton is and will always be the reason country music has been so strong in the SF Bay area.

John Shomby (yes, you) Mike McVay and Greg Frey for helping transform our programming landscape while I was at Cumulus.
