



## MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Two new entries into the top 20 and the powers chart this week. They are both in the hip/hop/rap arena which, again, shows that this format is still searching for its mass appeal identity. Female rapper, Kali, enters at #19 with the song "Area Codes" supported by a strong, creative video that ranks second overall and 10th in audio streams. Airplay is extremely minimal ranked way down at #49. Meanwhile, Lil Durk is back with some help from J Cole with "All My Life" which debuts at 16 overall with a solid, early sales and streaming story ranking as the 11th seller, 7th in video and 2nd in audio streams. Being in the 46th position in airplay shows that the panel will probably sit on this for a while.

The biggest upward move of the week was only three places, but it came from one of the format's superstars, Taylor Swift, with "Karma" going 16 to 13. The two drivers for this one are callout ranking 11th and actually airplay as the songs rises to 8th. The "Eras" tour helping there. Post Malone's "Chemical" solidifies its spot in the top 15 moving up to 14th this week selling through very well ranked 8th. Airplay is at number 6, so the panel is 100% behind a song that is right down the middle of the format's wheelhouse.

A couple of moves in a top 10 that was pretty stagnant overall. Metro Boomin's "Creepin" featuring The Weeknd and 21 Savage moves 10 to 9 driven by its consistent #1 rank in callout plus top 15 in audio streaming. The melodic "Favorite Song" from Toosi continues to impress rising two spots to number 5 based on some strong streaming numbers – 5th in video and 3rd in audio – and the fact that it's the number one seller this week. Airplay rank has risen three spots to #12 indicating that the panel is considering it as a possible favorite, too.

The remainder of the top 5 has not changed the past two weeks and now into week three. Miguel's "Sure Thing" sits at 4th hitting 9th in video streaming and 3rd in callout. In addition, it is the most played song of the entire 50 this week. Morgan Wallen's crossover smash "Last Night", hangs in at #3 and continues its sales and streaming success ranking 3rd in sales, 10th in video streams and 3rd in audio streams plus 7th in callout. Airplay stays at #10 so a bulk of the panel is playing it in a reasonable rotation. Holding at #2 is "Calm Down" from Rema and Selena Gomez. The song continues with its consistent performance ranking 6th in sales, 3rd in video streams, 11th in audio streams and 8th in callout. Miley Cyrus' "Flowers" remains in the top spot for the 5th straight week with big numbers across the board but remember that callout burn score of 20.4 will, most likely, slow this one down.

With 8 of the top 10 recurrents favoring the pop sound, apparently this is one way the panel keeps some balance in the format in the midst of the hip hop and country.

# THE CALLOUT *DIAGNOSIS* HOTAC

The respondents showed consistency this week in that the biggest hits remaining positive. One might think that's because there isn't anything new on the horizon that's showing potential, but you'd be wrong. We have several songs testing higher week over week as they begin a glacial climb. The logjam comes from the staying power of the Top-10 songs. High positives. Low burn. Strong familiarity. It's everything program directors look for in songs during both of the two most important rating sweeps.

There are several regionalized #1's across the panel this week. The leaders remain unchanged and are "Stay" The Kid Laroi & Justin Bieber, Metro Boomin with "Creepin'", Miley Cyrus and "Flowers", the song "Bad Habits" by Ed Sheeran, "Unstoppable" from Sia, "Heat Waves" Glass Animals, "Ghost" by Justin Bieber, "I'm Good (Blue)" performed by David Guetta & Bebe Rexha, Nicky Youre "Sunroof" and bringing up the rear of the Top-10 is "Levitating" by Dua Lipa.

Coi Leray and the song "Players" is the highest of the newer tunes testing strong. It's just outside the Top-10. Familiarity is over 90%. Total Positive is at 61.1% and the Burn/Tired Of score is only 10.8% Nationally. Once the tunes in front of it move to Recurrent on more stations, this one should see more positives coming with a greater more frequent spin count.

Miguel with "Sure Thing" is another fresh title testing well with a 60.2 Total Positive score. The tune is 88.2% Familiar. It's testing almost equally with women 25-32 and 33-39. These are the type of metrics that signal a chart-topping title. The song is ranked #13 Nationally, #12 Northeast, #11 in the Midwest, at #15 in the South and #19 in the West.

The song that appears to fall into a regionalized special focus category is "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen. It tests as a huge hit in the South. The song is #5 in that region. Which makes sense since he's a monster artist in the country format arena. #18 in the West. #13 in the Midwest. #23 in the Northeast. The song ranks #14 on the National test panel. The familiarity at the Hot AC format shouldn't surprise anyone as the song received a ton of airplay on country radio and sat at the top of the airplay charts longer than what is the norm for that format.




