

MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

There may be a new summer hit on the horizon. Debuting at #17 overall on the Power chart, and back after close to a year even stronger, is Dua Lipa with a very straight-down-the-middle "Dance The Night". A huge seller already ranked 9th plus a respectable 20th in audio streaming but the bigger story is stations are leaping on to this one as it's already up to 14th in only the second week of airplay. There really is no big callout story yet but we'll see what happens as the song grows within the panel.

Making a big move into the top 10 this week going from 12 to 8 overall in only 4 weeks' time is K-Pop Female Group, Fifty Fifty and "Cupid". Streaming is the big story here especially on the video with a number one rank there and 7th in audio streams. Stations are getting behind it more each week as the airplay rises two spots to 17. This format needs some pure pop and the two above mentioned tunes fit that role perfectly.

If you would have told me two months ago that I would be talking about Luke Combs crossing over into Top 40, I would have had some serious doubts about your sanity. But now – let's look at reality. Luke Combs' cover of the 80's hit "Fast Car" has now moved up two more positions on the Power chart to 9th overall this week. Sales and Streaming are behind this one with the song at number 2 in sales and 4th in audio streaming. More of the panel is getting on board, also, as the airplay rank increases six places up to number 23. Lots of new believers tells me that Mr. Combs has officially crossed over. Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" sits at 4th dropping one spot but is still a monster at number in 3 sales and number one in audio streams plus 8th in callout. Staying at 10th in airplay for the third week indicates that whoever is on it is on it and whoever is not, won't be.

A couple of top 25 songs to keep an eye on include Post Malone's newest tune "Mourning" which rises to 23 from 28 last week. His "Chemical" sits at 16th week with just about all the panel covering it while the other is making its way through sales ranking 12th. The airplay rank going from 25 to 21 tells us that stations are deciding that two Post Malone current songs in the rotation is not that big of a deal. Once again, these two fit that middle of the road pop area that the format so desperately needs.

Jonas Brothers' "Waffle House", after a strong debut three weeks ago, jumps back up three spots to 22 this week with lots of airplay behind it ranking 12th. There's not a big story in any other category but this, again, is another down-the-middle pop tune. We will watch how this plays out. I'd still be cautious with these guys right now unless they are touring through your market this summer.

Making the biggest jump of the week all the way into the top 5 is Taylor Swift and "Karma" going from 13 to 3! Tay-Tay is looking good across the board as she dazzles at stadium shows every weekend so far on her "Eras" tour. The song is the number one seller, a streaming giant ranking 5th with video and 3rd in audio and 11th in callout. The panel is totally on board with an airplay rank of 7th. With numbers like these, I see stations getting this into heavy (if not already) by the beginning of next week.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

The songs that drive and/or maintain ratings at Hot AC, for this week, are Metro Boomin "Creepin'", "Stay" The Kid Laroi & Justin Bieber, Miley Cyrus and "Flowers", the song "Bad Habits" by Ed Sheeran, "Unstoppable" from Sia, "Heat Waves" Glass Animals, "Ghost" by Justin Bieber, "I'm Good (Blue)" performed by David Guetta & Bebe Rexha, Nicky Youre "Sunroof" and "Levitating" by Dua Lipa.

The song that continues to appear to fall into a regionalized special focus category is "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen. It tests as a huge hit in the South. And that's easily explained since he's a monster artist in the country format arena. The song ranks high on the National test panel. The familiarity at the Hot AC format shouldn't surprise anyone as the song continues to receive a ton of airplay on country radio as a recurrent.

The UPS and Downs; "Unholy" by Sam Smith and Kim Petras is starting to lose altitude. The song is down to #13 Nationally. The burn is only at 14.7% and that bodes well for the tune continuing as a power recurrent. Picking up speed and height is "Baby Don't Hurt Me" by David Guetta f/Anne-Marie and Coi Leray is showing growth as it moves into the teens. The song lacks familiarity. When it becomes more familiar, it should show more positives. One of the puzzling things to note about this song is that it tests better with the upper end of the research panel. Ages 25-32 gives it a 50.6 Total Positive. Females 33-39 posts a 64.4 Total Positive.

The songs showing burn, in need of a slower rotation, include Harry Styles "As It Was", the aforementioned "Unholy" by Sam Hunt & Kim Petras, Meghan Trainor "Made You Look" is starting to ramp-up the Tired Of score. Miley Cyrus "Flowers" is at 15.6% and the song that is the crispiest is Dua Lipa's former #1 song "Levitating" is at 16.5%. It has to be noted that even as high as the Tired Of score is for "Levitating" ... none of the songs are burning so badly that they need to be dropped. Lots of positives to offset the negatives.

New songs to checkout and watch over the next few weeks include Dua Lipa "Dance the Night." Harry Styles is back at it with "Satellite." Hozier "Eat Your Young", "Dancing With Your Shadows" by Phillip Phillips and "Mine" by Kelly Clarkson. My new favorite song that I'll be watching closely is "That's Not How This Works" by Charlie Puth f/ Dan + Shay. A bit of nostalgia comes to this weeks research in the way of Matchbox Twenty and the song "Wild Dogs (Running in a Slow Dream)." Who hasn't dreamt of dogs running slowly?





CHARTS/POWERS:

- **1 AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
