MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

A couple of impressive new tunes on this week's Powers Chart. Debuting at 22 in its first week, and from the HBO series "The Idol", The Weeknd may have another hit with the song "Popular". He does have some help from rapper Playboi Carti and some "newbie" named Madonna. Seriously, this song marks the 5th decade the "material girl" has made it on to the charts. It's selling well already ranking 6th in sales and top 15 in audio streaming. Stations are already picking up on this because of the show, the collaboration and the star power of The Weeknd positioned at #34 in airplay for the week. This is one of those musical "events" which the panel should take note sooner rather than later.

Bringing back a cut from her "Lover" album and just re-released on the "More Lover Chapter EP", Taylor Swift's "Cruel Summer", which charted for a short time in 2019, looks as if it might have a better run now already moving from 28 to 20 overall with top 20 numbers in sales, audio streams and callout. The panel is just getting re-acquainted with an airplay rank of 35. It's summer....it's a song with "Summer" in the title....it's Taylor.....hmmmm...what to do?

The other quick starter is another one of those "reaction" songs that could work so well with Top 40. Female rapper, I-Candy samples KC & The Sunshine Band's 70's hit "Boogie Shoes" in "Keep Dat" which breaks in to the top 25 at number 23 up all the way from 31. Coming off a Tik Tok explosion, the song is already 8th in callout and top 15 in video streams. It's another one just getting the panel's attention sitting at 41st in airplay. Might be one that could set you apart from the station across the street.

Still keeping an eye on those country crossovers, I see Luke Combs' "Fast Car" in an upward trajectory going 9 to 8 this week overall. It remains the top seller of the entire 50 ranking 3rd in audio streaming and 10th in callout. Stations are playing it enough for the song to be at 22nd in airplay which leads me to believe that's a medium for most.

Meanwhile, Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" continues its crossover run moving up one spot to 3rd overall this week as the number 2 seller (ironic that the top two in sales are country crossovers!), number one audio streamer and 7th in callout. Most of the panel is on it with some powering and some not as it sits at number 9 in airplay. It's a monster song and should be played as often as possible.

The top 5 is very familiar with SZA's "Kill Bill" back in there moving from 6 to 5. She's top 5 in both audio streaming and callout and 9th in video streams. It has shown some high burn with an 11.7 so be careful as you move forward. Taylor Swift's "Karma" drops one spot to 4th but remains solid across the board. Airplay is top 5 so stations are not backing off as of yet. We did mention Morgan Wallen at 3rd. Still at number 2 is Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" with strong ranks in all categories. Lots of life left in it. Finally, despite the high burn with this, Miley Cyrus' "Flowers" is still number one after 8 weeks based on its high ranks in all four categories. I would highly recommend getting this one out of heavy very soon, if not now.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

Summer is flying by and there are two songs that seem to be growing in acceptance and posting some nice positives. "Sure Thing" by Miguel and "Calm Down" by Rema & Selena Gomez. They both play to the rhythmic feeling that's splashing over to Hot AC from the CHR/Top-40 format. Morgan Wallen "Last Night" continues showing strength and no signs of slowing down. David Guetta' song with Anne-Marie & Coi Leray titled "Baby Don't Hurt Me" is a predicted hit. "Anti-Hero" by Taylor Swift seems to perform the best in those regions where Taylor is performing. She is this generations "Beatles" so that should be no surprise.

Question; what do these songs have in common? The Kid Laroï & Justin Bieber "Stay", Miley Cyrus "Flowers", Sia "Unstoppable", Metro Boomin and "Creepin'", Ed Sheeran "Bad Habits", Glass Animals "Heat Waves", "Sunroof" by Nicky Youre, "Ghost" sung by Justin Bieber, Dua Lipa's song "Levitating" and "I'm Good (Blue)" by David Guetta and Bebe Rexha. The answer; They are the Top-10 researching songs of the week. They're mostly titles that could be Recurrents for many. Solidifying the theory that familiarity is important to the audience.

Despite the need for familiarity, and for consistency, variety is an important element in music radio. Living in a world where people create their own "format" by listening to a variety of radio stations and streaming platforms, the value of variety has grown, which has expanded some playlists. To that end, songs like "Fast Car" by Luke Combs bring familiarity and variety to a radio station. New songs by established artists like Taylor Swift and her latest track "Karma" does that. The same goes for Meghan Trainor with "Made You Look." These tracks all show good positive scores with a low burn factor.

This weeks' results are a bit different than in the most recent weeks in that there is a different Number One sone in each region. Number one in the Northeast is "Unstoppable" by Sia. In the Midwest it's Glass Animals and "Heatwaves." "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin is the best researching song in the South. The #1 highest testing song in the West is "Stay" by The Kid Laroï and Justin Bieber. There are no songs above 16% in Burn. The Hot AC audience appears to be very satisfied with the music selections that they've heard. What that should equate to for the spring rating sweep is good Time Spent Listening equating to a better AQH.

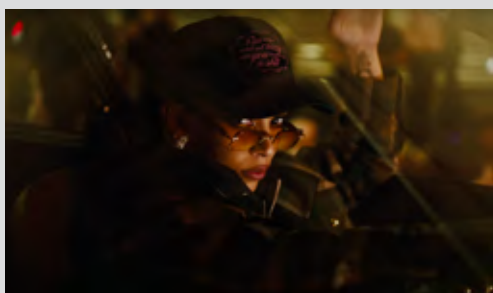

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
