# **MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE**

Rapper L'il Durk may have found two perfect combinations as he places one song in the top 10 and one enters the top 25 this week. He first is a very likely collaboration. The other – not so much. The melodic "All My Life" with some help from fellow rapper J Cole makes it into the overall top 10 this week moving up three spots. The song has a definite sales and streaming story ranking 6th in sales, 8th in video streams and all the way up to number 2 in audio streaming. Airplay sits at 26th showing that the panel is getting it on the air, at least, with a couple of spins a day. Meanwhile, the very unlikely combination of L'il Durk and, of all people, Morgan Wallen, debuts at number 24 overall this week. "Stand By Me" is showing early sales and streaming growth but not much of the panel behind it yet. With the success of Morgan's "Last Night" at Top 40, don't be surprised if this one gets a good run.

In a format in need of some pure pop, there is always Taylor Swift. Her re-release of "Cruel Summer" moves up overall for the second straight week going from 20 to 15. Top 15 in sales, audio streaming and callout, the panel is getting on it quickly as the airplay rises from 35 to 28. She's a core artist for the format and that's sorely needed right now.

Female rapper Kali's "Area Codes" makes her own 5-point jump from 21 to 16 with top 10 sales, 2nd in audio streams and 16th in callout already. Stations are slowly getting involved with the airplay rank going from 45 to 39. It's early for this one but it is one of those reaction songs Top 40, historically, thrives on.

Luke Combs' "Fast Car" stays at 8th this week even though it's the top seller, 3rd with audio streams and 10th in callout. Airplay rank remains at number 22 so it's safe to say that it will, most likely, stay in medium for the duration.

The top 5 has one change this week with Miguel's "Sure Thing" getting back in at number 5 moving up two spots. The amazing story of this song continues. Originally released in 2011, it gets revived through TikTok earlier this year and it's been off to the races ever since. Ranking 3rd in callout and 12th in video streams, it's the most played song by the panel for a third straight week. With the callout burn score still in single digits, I'd keep this as a power.

Hanging at 4th is another Taylor Swift smash "Karma". Sales and streaming are primarily driving this one although callout is decent, ranked at number 12 this week. I don't see this one going away anytime soon. Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" continues its crossover success at number 3 again this week. It's the number one audio streamer and number two seller plus 8th in callout. Most of the panel appears to have this one in heavy ranking 8th in airplay.

Dropping from the top spot to number 2 after an 8-week run there is Miley Cyrus' "Flowers". She's still top 5 in sales and callout but that 19.2 overall burn score is starting to work against her as her airplay begins to drop where she's down to third, but I predict we will see a bigger drop next week, especially with her new one "Jaded" starting to move.

# THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

The Summer Solstice arrived this past week, but we've seen radio playlists that have been focusing on energy since Memorial Day Weekend. The respondents are focused on what they like and what they dislike. The high-testing "Likes" are centered on mostly re-currents. The Kid Laroi & Justin Bieber "Stay", Miley Cyrus "Flowers", Sia "Unstoppable", Metro Boomin with "Creepin'", Ed Sheeran "Bad Habits", Glass Animals "Heat Waves", "Sunroof" by Nicky Youre, "Ghost" sung by Justin Bieber, Dua Lipa's song "Levitating" and "I'm Good (Blue)" by David Guetta and Bebe Rexha.

The two freshest songs, with the most growth and positive scores, are "Sure Thing" by Miguel and "Calm Down" by Rema & Selena Gomez. Miguel is testing Top-3 with the Top-40 Panel. The title is testing the best with the younger side of the sample. That is Females 25-32. Although it also shows strength with Females 33-39. Morgan Wallen's song "Last Night" is now testing Top-10 with a positive score in the 60s. "Jaded" by Miley Cyrus is starting to accelerate with positives. It's already 83% familiar and showing the kind of positives that her song "Flowers" showed initially.

There is some positive growth for "Fast Car" by Luke Combs. Perhaps because of the familiarity of this remake of a Tracy Chapman song. Taylor Swift and her latest track "Karma" is showing early signs that it will be a hit. Meghan Trainor's latest song "Made You Look" showed an initially strong start, then bounced around a bit, before stabilizing by showing good positive scores with a low burn factor.

The Tired Of factor remains low for this week's test group. There are no songs above 17.3% Burn. That one song is Dua Lipa with "Levitating." The Hot AC audience appears to be very satisfied with the music selections that they're hearing. The spring survey has concluded. This would be the time to freshen your playlists and spike some songs here and there to see if they catch-on. ## CHARTS/POWERS:

**1 AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. **5 STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

**6 SALES** is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

## HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

## RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

## ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

## STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
