MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

The sound top 40 needs the most right now – straight ahead pop- comes to us in the form of this week's two biggest movers. There may actually be some light at the end of the tunnel. Dua Lipa's "Dance The Night" has made believers out of most of the panel as it moves 19 to 14 overall. The song is a big seller at number 8 and ranked 10th in airplay. Callout and streaming lags but, at this point, that doesn't matter. The artist's track record and the sound lead the way.

Taylor Swift, already with three hits from her "Midnights" album, is having early success with a 3-year-old cut "Cruel Summer" that rises 4 spots to number 11 this week. This one has an across-the-board story with top sales and streaming and decent callout at number 17. Stations are picking up on it more each week as the airplay rank goes from 28 to 21. Perfect pop sound.....seasonal reference.....core artist.....big tour.....need I say more?

A couple of other tunes to keep an eye on are the haunting "Daylight" from David Kushner moving 20 to 17 overall this week. A strong video (ranked 5th) and more than adequate callout (11th) is giving the panel more reason to spin it with the airplay rising 5 spots to number 30. SZA's follow-up to the amazing "Kill Bill" called "Snooze" is very much awake (there I go again!), breaking into the top 15 for the first time sitting at 15th from number 18 last week. Moving into the top 20 in streams, stations appear to be good with two SZA songs in rotation with this one ranked 16th in airplay this week.

Luke Combs' "Fast Car" continues its unlikely run toward the top moving 8th to 7th overall this week. The song is the number one seller, the number 2 audio streamer and 9th in callout. Stations are primarily giving it medium airplay as it rises two to number 20. He may look like a country artist, but this song has made it to top 40 with lots of room to spare. The other country crossover smash, "Last Night" from Morgan Wallen hangs at #3 again this week as the number one audio streamer, 2nd in sales, 4th in callout and 7th in airplay. No doubt a heavy.

Four of the rest of the top 5 remain the same as last week, except for one new entry – Toosi's "Favorite Song" going 6 to 4. Top 15 in sales and callout and top 5 in streaming, this rapper going mellow has the panel getting into it with an airplay rank at number 11 this week. Looks like a hit from here!

Parked at number one for the second consecutive week is "Calm Down" from Rema and Selena Gomez. Excellent numbers across the board plus the 2nd most played song in the format behind Miguel's "Sure Thing" staying at number 5 this week driven by its continued callout success ranking 2nd.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

The big day is Tuesday. Fireworks have been firing off in the distance all weekend. This week's research is pointing out some explosive songs and a couple that haven't shown the sparkle that we thought we'd have seen by now. The burn ratio is low overall and some legacy songs continue to be on fire at the top of the research. One thing is for sure. Unless you want a lifelong nickname that has to do with a firecracker accident, be sure to light it and throw it. Happy Independence Day!

Glass Animals with "Heatwaves" tops the best testing list. Appropriate for what's happening weatherwise in the Southwest. "Stay" by The Kid Laroi and Justin Bieber shows a 66.5% Positive score with a low burn result at 11.9%. Metro Boomin' comes through with "Creepin'" as the #3 best testing tune. Total positive is 66.1% and burn is at 12.9%. "Unstoppable" by Sia, which is inarguably her best testing and longest running hit, ranks #4 in Total Positive and has a Tired Of score of 16.0%. The song is finally showing signs of burning out.

Ed Sheeran "Bad Habits" is one of those songs with a high acceptance and Total Positive score that puts the song squarely in the power category. Except that the songs' tenure on the charts puts it in the recurrent category. The song has a Total Positive of 64.7%. It is testing decidedly stronger with Females 33-39 showing a Total Positive of 67.8% while the Female 25-32 is showing a Total Positive of 61.8%.

Miley Cyrus is killing it with "Flowers." While I'm sure there's much desire to play her other two new songs more, this one still tests power-worthy. It can do quite well as a recurrent given it's #6 rank overall. Those titles that are continuing to show the potential for a really long-lasting run, based on research, also includes Morgan Wallen with an 86.6% Familiar score and a Total Positive of 62.2%. Tired Of (Total Burn) is only 6.5%. That's impressive given the familiarity score for this song. Likely driven by it's number one performance at the Country format.

The Tired Of factor remains overall low for this week's test group. The Total Burn for Nicky Youre "Sunroof" is getting up there at 17.5%. Dua Lipa with "Levitating" leads the Crispy Critter category at 18.1% while "As It Was" by Harry Styles is at 17.0% and Lizzo pulls a 15.8 with "About Damn Time." The Hot AC audience appears to be happy with what they've been hearing. No real drop-off in overall acceptance from this panel.

Reviewing this week's research, pay attention to Miguel "Sure Thing", "Kill Bill" by SZA, Miley Cyrus' song "Jaded", Taylor Swifts "Cruel Summer" which seems appropriate for the season and Harry Styles "Satellite." These titles are showing that the audience is interested in what's being played on the radio. Radio remains an important factor in music discovery. Research shows the way.

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
