MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Apparently "Barbie" is planning on taking over the Top 40 Power chart for a while. Three songs from the record-breaking movie make it into the top 20 this week. Someone who has a knack for getting on movie soundtracks, Billie Eilish, enters at number 19 this week all the way from 47th last week with the sultry ballad "What Was I Made For?". Of course, it's too early for any callout but the song, right now, is driven totally by sales (ranked 6th) and audio streams (9th). Airplay is almost non-existent at this point, but we'll see how much impact the movie has on playing this very slow song on a large number of panel stations.

A second song on the chart from "Barbie" comes from superstar Dual Lipa and "Dance The Night" which remains at number 15 this week. Sales and streaming are both pretty good with callout lagging behind but airplay is strong ranking 8th this week. The panel jumped on this one right away and has been playing it like crazy as evidenced by its top 10 ranking on Mediabase after only 9 weeks.

Finally, Nicki Minaj and Ice Spice, with help from Aqua, have continued their quick chart ascent with "Barbie World" rising into the top 10 up 3 spots to 9th. It's a big streamer sitting at 6th in both, plus 11th in sales and a callout story already ranking 12th. Airplay is just starting to grow at 29 and at number 27 in Mediabase in only 4 weeks time. This is definitely one to watch for the panel.

Two other debuts in the top 30 of note: Country star Jellyroll's "Need A Favor" is starting to show up especially with sales and streams as it debuts on the overall chart at 28. Airplay is very low now at 47 but my gut tells me to not ignore this one in the weeks ahead. One of the vocalists from K-Pop sensation, BTS, is making his mark. Jung Kook's "Seven" debuts at number 26 overall driven solely by the panel as it already ranks 25th in airplay in its first week. There is no sales, streaming or callout story yet but I'm guessing there will be.

Another new entry into the top 10 comes from L'il Durk with an assist from J Cole "All My Life" moving from 11th to 8th overall. Its strength is in sales (10th) and streaming (9th and 5th respectively). The song is beginning to catch hold at callout at number 20 and airplay is increasing at 16th as the song jumps into the Mediabase top 20. Looking more each week like a hit.

The top 5 is comprised of the same 5 songs as last week but a few changes including a new number one. Olivia Rodrigo's "Vampire" remains at 5th which, after only three weeks, is a great sign for the song. Callout is still slow to develop and may stay that way because of the sound of the song but sales, streaming and airplay are top 5 so it's a panel favorite. Still ranked 4th after 28 weeks on the chart, Miley Cyrus' "Flowers", despite a callout burn score is 5th there, 7th in sales and 7th on airplay telling us that the burn is not as big a deal at this point. Dropping from 2nd to 3rd, Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" stays strong with top 10 numbers across the board and the 2nd most played song of the 50 surveyed. Morgan Wallen's crossover hit "Last Night" drops from one to two on the overall chart with still amazing numbers in all categories only because the format's number one star, Taylor Swift, takes "Cruel Summer" to the top spot from 3 last week. Top sales and streaming, 7th in callout and up to 3rd in airplay, she is more of what this format needs.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

July is rounding the corner to home and August is in the On-Deck Circle. Spring ratings are almost finished returning everywhere. Programmers whose stations performed well are geniuses. Those whose stations performed less than well in the survey are questioning everything. It is times like this that you rely on what your audience is telling you. No opinion counts more than the listeners. The research that's presented every week in Monday Morning Intel is built on a large sample of music radio listeners and segmented nationally and by regions.

The songs with the highest positive scores are "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin. That song is ranked #1 in every region except for the Midwest where it drops to #2. "Heat Waves" by Glass Animals, "Stay" by the Kid Laroï & Justin Bieber, Sia "Unstoppable", and bring-up the 5th spot of the Top-5 is "Bad Habits" by Ed Sheeran. The next five include Miley Cyrus, Morgan Wallen, Miguel, Dua Lipa and Justin Bieber. Luke Combs is showing a flattening of growth with the song "Fast Cars." My suspicion is that it's because of the logjam at the top of the test panel.

I'm excited to see Boone Benson jumping up the research ranks with the song "In The Stars." It gives the format a chance to be fresh and provide more variety. The title is 83.3% Familiar with a Total Positive of 56.4% and a Total Burn score at 7.9% overall. The song is testing slightly better with Females 33-39 at 60.2% while Females 25-32 comes in at 52.8%. A number of other new songs show up this week. Titles by Fall Out Boy, Dua Lipa, FIFTY FIFTY, Shinedown, Olivia Rodrigo and Dominic Fike. Many of these songs are still growing in familiarity, but their potential is clear.

The one to watch as a sure bet to reach the power category is a song by Harry Styles. The former One Direction band member appears in this week's research with "Satellite" as his follow-up to "As It Was." The song is still building Positives. The National Total Positive is only at 35.2% so far. Familiarity is reaching a good level with 66.9% Nationally. The artists is familiar. The rapid growth in positives should be reflected in greater acceptance over the next several weeks.

Comparing past research results, the top five songs are roughly the same with a slight juggling of position. The Weekend "Die For You" Total Positive is at 55.7 this week. Total Positive score last week was 56.8 Total Positive. It's a song that is likely going to have a long lifecycle at Hot AC. Luke Combs "Fast Car" is flat from last week and the week before as the 14th best researching title. Ignore the mild controversy around the songs lyrics and meaning. It's a strong song that you can't go wrong by playing.

CHARTS/POWERS:

6 SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
