# MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

"Barbie" first rules the movies and now it's Top 40 radio with three songs from the soundtrack on the Powers chart top 20, including two of them in the top 5. Moving up 7 spots from 24-17 this week is the Billie Eilish tune, prominent in the movie, "What Was I Made For?" Callout is just starting to take hold as it's in the top 30, but sales and streaming are both top 10 giving the song the big boost this week. In addition, the panel is getting more involved as airplay rises from 47 last week to 36th this week. I wouldn't get left behind not playing the big music from this movie.

With the pop sound so needed on Top 40 right now, Dua Lipa's "Dance The Night" rises three spots to number 5 overall this week. Top 5 in sales and Top 10 in streaming with airplay at number 7 overall, the last piece is callout and a seven-spot move to number 21 this week shows that listeners remember this well from the movie.

Finally, the hip-hop/rap "Barbie World" from Nicki Minaj and Ice Spice, with help from Aqua, remains 4th this week with top 10 sales and top 5 streams and callout. This is looking more like a medium for the panel this week with airplay breaking into the top 20 at number 19. This is all happening after only 6 weeks!

The country crossovers continue to do well with Jellyroll's "Need a Favor" breaking into the top 20 at number 20 overall mostly driven by a top 5 rank in sales and 20th at callout. The panel is starting to warm up to it with airplay moving up four spots to number 39. Luke Combs' "Fast Car" hangs at number 7 again this week as the top seller and number 4 audio streamer. Callout is still good at 12th overall while airplay is approaching the heavy rotation area moving from 11th to 9th. Would you have thought we'd be talking about Luke Combs even ON a top 40 station at the beginning of '23?

Morgan Wallen's "Last Night" may have peaked as it falls to 3rd from the top spot last week. It's still the number one audio streamer and 3rd in sales plus 5th at callout. Some of the panel is backing off it as the airplay ranks falls 6 places to 11th. An excellent run for the country superstar. Will there be another top 40 hit in his future?

Rounding out the top 5, Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" still has some life moving back up from 3 to 2 overall this week. With top 10 sales, top 5 video streams and Top 15 audio streaming and callout, the panel is still solidly behind this with the song being the second most played of all. You must pay attention to that 13.0 callout burn score as you move ahead, though.

Taylor Swift takes another one to number one, this time in only 8 weeks' time. "Cruel Summer" moves to the top from number two last week as, once again, it's the most played song of the 50 surveyed plus top 8 numbers across all categories.

There are three recurrenents I think you should keep your eye on for continued heavy airplay as they are the top three of the thirty researched. "Creepin'" from Metro Boomin with The Weeknd and 21 Savage, Sza's "Kill Bill" and The Weeknd's "Die For You". Don't discount all or any combination of these three to continue in your heavies.

# THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

It's extreme heat in much of the United States ... and that mirrors the heat that some titles are absorbing via the Tired Of score. Dua Lipa is crispy with "Levitating" at 18.7%, Harry Styles "As It Was" is sitting at 17.5% burn and Miley Cyrus' song "Flowers" is at 16.7%. Lizzo's track "About Damn Time" is flashing a score of 16.3% and the fifth most "Burn" score goes to "Stay" by the Kid Laroï which has a 16.2% in the "tired of" category.

Benson Boone "In The Stars" continues to be the freshest title that's testing well. The song now ranks as the 14th best testing title, up from 15th last week. Total positive is 59.3%. Familiarity is 85.9%. The burn is a 6.8%. This tune is testing best in the South where it's the 5th best testing title. In the West it comes in at #10. If you're not exposing this song across all dayparts, you're missing a song with a strong Total Positive score. The best testers based on region show "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin as #1 in the Northeast, Midwest, South and West. A rare across the board best testing song by an artist that was largely unknown at the start of the year. The #2 best testing song varies by region. "Stay" by The Kid Laroï & Justin Bieber is in second in the Northeast. "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen is #1 in the Midwest and South. "Unstoppable" by Sia is in the second spot ... after a year of high testing research results.

It's interesting to see various Country songs continue to cross over and score strongly across the nation. The aforementioned Morgan Wallen song "Last Night" is the highest testing of those songs that are drafting off of the Hot AC format. Luke Combs with "Fast Car" is testing power. Jelly Roll "Need a Favor" is a square peg in a round hole ... and clearly loved by multiple audiences. Big upside with this unique performer.

We're always looking for fresh titles that research well and have the potential to become catalog songs for the format. Despite what is still low familiarity, tunes to keep an eye and ear on include Kelly Clarkson "Mine", Harry Styles "Satellite", "Runaway" by OneRepublic, "Vampire" by Olivia Rodrigo, Maroon 5 with "Middle Ground", Lauren Daigle "Thank God I Do", "Sail Away" Lovely the Band, and "Mona Lisa" by Dominic Fike.

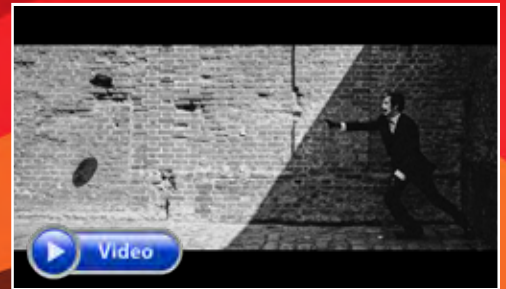

## CHARTS/POWERS:

**1 AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

**2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE** predicts listener tune-in/tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

**3 NATIONAL CALLOUT** contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

**4 STREAMING, AUDIO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

**5 STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

**6 SALES** is based on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

## HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

## RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

## ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

## STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
