It was just announced that the "Barbie" movie is Warner's most successful in history. Now the soundtrack is making its mark with two songs in the top 5 and three in the top 15 on this week's Powers chart. Coming on quickly is Billie Eilish's powerful ballad "What Was I Made For?", in only its second week, goes 17 to 13 overall driven by top 5 sales and streaming although she just broke into the top 20 at number 20 in callout. More of the panel is considering the movie's popularity over the song's temp as the airplay rank rises 8 spots from 36 to 28. Dua Lipa's poppy "Dance The Night" from the movie moves up one to 4th overall after 12 weeks. Callout is starting to kick in ranking 19th while sales and streaming numbers are very impressive in the top 5. In addition, it is now the sixth most played song of the 50 surveyed. Finally, with only 7 weeks of chart life, "Barbie World", the rap entry in the movie from Nicki Minaj and Ice Spice, with Aqua helping out, sits at number 2 overall moving up from the 3rd spot last week. Top 10 in sales and ranked 2nd in streaming and callout, airplay is continuing to pick up sitting at number 15. Looks like a solid medium right now for some but do know there is a 10.4 callout burn score that you should keep an eye on for the next few weeks.

The other big move of the week comes from another ballad – David Kushner's "Daylight" – moving from 18 to 14 overall this week. Callout and sales are driving this one with a top 15 sales rank and 7th in callout. The panel is seeing some value in this as the airplay rank enters the top 20 at number 19, from 22 last week. Just have some tempo around it.

A couple of country crossovers are still occupying space on the Powers chart. Jellyroll's "Need A Favor" rises one spot to 19th overall with top 5 sales and top 20 streams and callout. The panel has not yet really warmed up to this yet with airplay going from just 39 to 35. Meanwhile, Luke Combs' "Fast Car" moves 7 to 6. It's the number one seller, the number three audio streamer and 11th in callout. Airplay ranks remains at number 9 – a medium for some, heavy for some.

Taylor Swift has two in the top 15 including "Cruel Summer" which remains in the top spot overall as the number two seller, number one audio streams and 6th in callout plus continues to be the most played song on the chart again this week. Her previous number one "Karma" won't quit as it moves back up two spots to number 11 with top 15 sales and callout and top 10 airplay. The high callout burn score of 13.9 is evident as the panel starts to back down rotations in some places.

Highest debut honors go to Doja Cat with the female rapper's interesting "Paint the Town Red" which samples an early 60's hit, "Walk On By" from Dionne Warwick. It starts at number 15 in its first week with top 10 streams, 11th in sales and already at 22 in airplay. Another reaction song here and stations have already picked up on that!

Filling out the rest of the top 5 is the second most played song, Olivia Rodrigo's "Vampire" which goes 6 to 5 overall. Top 10 sales and top 5 streaming, callout has lagged. Yet another one that has charged upward in just a 7-week period. Dropping one spot from 2 to 3, but still a strong player, is "Calm Down" from Rema and Selena Gomez. The song remains viable with top 10 sales, streaming and callout. It's now the third most played song so stations are hanging in there even with a 13.0 callout burn score.

Summer is racing by and the Big Push before Q4 starts is about to be felt across radio and records in North America. Labels, Managers and Artists scrambling to have new music on-air at radio soon after Labor Day. Ride the life cycle of the song through the fall until the music world starts to plan for holiday vacations. That usually comes between Thanksgiving and December 15th. Those of us who reside at a radio station will be marking-up holiday schedules and fighting off sales reps with crazy Christmas promotions. Fun times.

Benson Boone "In The Stars" remains a bright star rising up the research charts. "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin is becoming a strong testing library song. "Stay" by The Kid Laroi & Justin Bieber continues to be well received. "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen is getting airplay on three formats and the research validates its' popularity. "Unstoppable" by Sia just won't die. The song is #1 in the Northeast and West. Who could've guessed that this amazing artist would have such a big hit that extends beyond a year of popularity.

Jelly Roll has arrived and is researching amazingly well with women 25-32 and 33-39. It's the #6 best testing song in the South and the #7 best tester in the Midwest. The National positive score is 60.3, showing only 5% burn and 85% familiarity. If you've seen this artist perform live, you get it without question. A showman with an unusual dramatically soulful voice and touching lyrics. This song is showing that within a few weeks it could become the best testing song for Hot AC.

Showing the signs of burnout are Harry Styles tune "As It Was" at 17.0%, "About Damn Time" by Lizzo has a Burn score of 16.2%, "Flowers" by Miley Cyrus shows 14.9% Tired Of and "Sunroof" performed by Nicky Youre is at 14.8% Tired Of score. Sia, with the song "Unstoppable", remains well received. Ms. Sia has only a 14.1% Burnout score.

Freshening up playlists is being fed by growth being shown by such artists as Kelly Clarkson with "Mine", Harry Styles has "Satellite", "Runaway" OneRepublic is catching-on with the research panel, "Vampire" by Olivia Rodrigo, Maroon 5's song "Middle Ground" and Lauren Daigle's tune "Thank God I Do" are slowly growing. Positive test scores are starting to show for "Sail Away" Lovely the Band, "Mona Lisa" by Dominic Fike and "Padam-Padam" by Kylie Minogue.

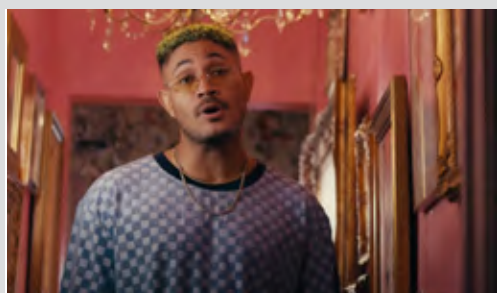

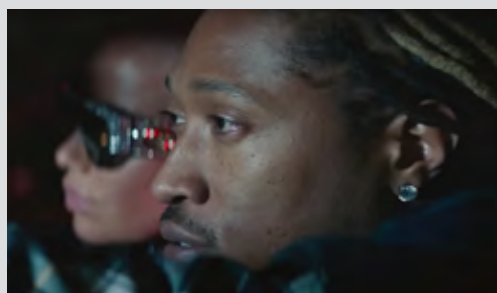

CHARTS/POWERS:

1 AIRPLAY is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE predicts listener tune-in/ tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

3 NATIONAL CALLOUT contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

4 STREAMING, AUDIO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

5 STREAMING, VIDEO contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

6 SALES is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.

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
