





MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Taylor, Olivia, and "Barbie" are the stars of this week's Powers chart. Taylor Swift, once again, has the number one song with "Cruel Summer" – a sales, streaming and callout giant. Add to that the fact that it's the most played song of the 50 surveyed. Her former number one "Karma" just keeps hanging in there moving back into the top 10 at number 10 overall this week driven by callout at number 10 and airplay at number 9. Keep in mind the higher callout burn scores of both songs as you move forward.


Then there's Olivia Rodrigo who already has a top 5 hit in "Vampire" which sits at number 5 again this week on this chart. Streaming is behind this one with top 5 numbers plus it's the second most played song of the bunch. Now she brings a possible second one, with a lot more tempo, to the chart debuting at number 20. The catchy "Bad Idea, Right?" is off to strong start ranking 6th in sales and 2nd already in audio streams. The panel is well aware of this one with an airplay at 27 in its first week. Perfect song for the format.

"Barbie" is the champ with three tunes now in the top 10. The pivotal song from the movie "What Was I Made For" from Billie Eilish is the big mover of the week rising from 13th to 9th overall. Top 5 sales and streaming and a big increase to 12th in callout, stations are hopping on it quickly as airplay goes from 28 to 23 this week. A powerful ballad from the biggest movie of the year. No brainer here!

Dua Lipa's "Dance the Night" is one of two from the movie in the top 5 at number 3 this week. Strong sales and streaming with decent callout and an airplay rank up to 4th indicates that this is just what the format is needing. A right down the middle pop hit. Finally, at the other end of the spectrum and remaining at number two is Nicki Minaj and Ice Spice with help from Aqua and "Barbie World". Streaming and callout are driving this plus the panel is solidly in place as the airplay jumps from 15 to 11.

Two country crossover possibilities sit comfortably in the top 20. Jellyroll's "Need a Favor" moves up to number 18 as the number three seller and top 20 streams and callout. The panel is nowhere close to convinced yet, though, with airplay at 33 out of 50. Meanwhile, Luke Combs' "Fast Car" HAS crossed over remaining at number 6 this week as the number one seller, 3rd in audio streams and 9th in callout. All of that is giving stations more confidence to play it more often with airplay up to number 8 this week.

One to definitely keep an eye on is female rapper Doja Cat's melodic "Paint The Town Red" which rises to 14th overall. Strong sales and streaming lead the way and the number of stations is growing with airplay up to 19th. With this all happening after only three weeks, it should be enough of a message to that part of the panel being cautious.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

Labor Day weekend starts this Friday. Looking at those songs that test the best as a Total Favorite, "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin' continues to be a monster performing song. Morgan Wallen has the second most favorite song with "Last Night." "Flowers" by Miley Cyrus continues to do very well. Showing signs that predict a top testing song position is Jely Roll's "Need a Favor." The song is already the #6 researching song for Hot AC and maintains the #2 position among the Country research sample. This artist is for real and his appeal goes far beyond country.

It was an unusual week for the test panel. Metro Boomin' has the best testing song Nationally. The Northeast scored the same song as the best of the titles being researched. The Midwest is all about Luke Combs and the song "Fast Car." Glass Animals song "Heat Waves" is the best tester in the South. Sia is the highest testing song in the west with "Unstoppable." The most familiar songs always show the highest positive or highest negative, but this song by Sia shows no signs of testing poorly. Burn is only at 12.5%.

Because the format is always looking for lightening rod songs that can engage an audience, one to drill down on as you review the research is Miguel and "Sure Thing." The song comes in as the 10th best testing track this week. It is testing slightly better with the younger end of the sample (Women 25-32) by posting a Positive score of 60.3%. The upper end (Women 33-39) tabulated to 55.9% Positive. The Total Positive across both age cells puts the song at 58.1% with women 25-39. The song itself is a strong performer and the sound of the tune fits with Hot AC's overall feeling to be as much like a Top-40 as possible, but with more familiarity and more gold titles.

This week's research panel heard multiple tracks by several artists. Future legends including Taylor Swift, Ed Sheeran, and Harry Styles. The presence of music by well-known names is always a positive, too. Post Malone, The Weeknd, Miley Cyrus, Dua Lipa and Train will give the format a feeling of familiarity and comfort. All of which is a good thing to enable an audience have a Sing-Along moment.

Next up are new songs by the likes of Fifty-Fifty by Cupid. The song is new making the familiarity score low for the song, but it still posted 77.6% ... which is not shabby for a new title. We also saw good research for several newer songs. They included Kelly Clarkson with "Mine", Harry Styles has "Satellite", "Runaway" OneRepublic is catching-on with the research panel, "Vampire" by Olivia Rodrigo, Maroon 5's song "Middle Ground" and Lauren Daigle's tune "Thank God I Do" are slowly growing. Positive test scores are starting to show for "Sail Away" Lovely the Band, "Mona Lisa" by Dominic Fike and "Padam-Padam" by Kylie Minogue.



CHARTS/POWERS:

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
