The last thought from my "At A Glance" column last week was: "Will we see the name Oliver Anthony anywhere?". Look at number 22 on the Powers chart and there he is with "Rich Men North of Richmond", the most talked-about song of the year and maybe the decade. Of course, it's way too early for callout BUT it starts as the number one seller and streamer – video and audio. As we've seen over the past week, airplay is spotty with a handful of the panel really playing it, some highlighting it and some staying away from it. Right now, it's 46th out of 50 in airplay (61 in Mediabase) but that number will probably change in the next couple of weeks. No question this is a reaction song that the has had the audience out in front. If it's me, I'm playing it quickly and somewhat often and then goodbye, but it is an individual programmer decision with this one.

The highest debut, though, is credited to budding superstar Cody Johnson with his newest release "The Painter" which opens at number 19 overall. Sales and streaming are both strong while it's too early for callout. A little more than half of the panel is spinning it in light which puts it at 42 in airplay.

One more top 25 debut at number 24 comes from a singer/songwriter who has bounced around and built a loyal following over the past 6 years – Tyler Childers with his latest "In Your Love". Top 10 sales and streaming already, but the airplay is minimal. Very early for this but I'd still recommend keeping an eye on it.

Morgan Wallen, once again, lands two in the top 10. His single "Everything I Love" sticks at number 10 with top 15 sales and streaming and okay callout numbers. Airplay ranked at 13 tells us that this is a solid medium. The latest album cut getting attention "Thinkin' Bout Me" rises two spots to number 7 overall with a top 10 rank in sales and top 5 in streaming and callout. The panel is starting to pay attention as the airplay is up to 32. Considering the callout familiarity level is 91.8, the audience knows the song, so what's everyone waiting for? Hottest act in the format and the audience is telling you that this is the one.

The top 5 songs have not changed except that Lainey Wilson's "Watermelon Moonshine" and Kane Brown's "Bury Me in Georgia" exchanged spots with Lainey up to 4 and Kane down to 5. Kane's tune is top 15 sales and streaming, top 10 callout, and the 4th most played song of the week. Lainey is top 10 sales and streaming plus top 15 callout. Airplay is closing in on the power level ranking 8th. The top 3 is definitely THE top 3. Luke Combs' "Love You Anyway" remains third led by top 5 callout and the 2nd most played song. Jason Aldean's "Try That in a Small Town" made it through the controversy and is still at number two. It's top 5 sales and streaming, number one callout but entering the top 10 in airplay just this week at number 9. Time to power this one.

Number one for the second straight week is Jellyroll's "Need a Favor" with top 5 numbers across the board and, once again, the most played song of the 50.

NASHVILLE

You've spent a good part of your life in Nashville. Give us a little background on Kristen Williams prior to becoming a Senior VP for Warner Music Nashville.

I grew up in Brainerd, Minnesota. I was active in sports (tennis and fast pitch softball) and chorus which ultimately fueled my desire to move to Nashville. Yes, I thought I could sing country songs. My parents wouldn't allow me to move 1,000 miles from home without at least pursuing an education so at 19 years-old I transferred to Belmont University to study Music Business. I quickly realized the enormity of Nashville's talent pool and was thankful to be able to pursue a career on the business side of the music industry.

It's rare in this business that someone is with the same company for ten years, let alone 20!! What's the secret to the longevity?

I've been lucky enough to not only get along with all of my bosses but call them friends. However, the secret is to keep your head down and work hard. I was never looking for notoriety and I've never chased a title. When opportunities presented themselves I happened to be in the right place at the right time and I'm thrilled to say that Warner Music Nashville is still my home.

You run one of the biggest labels in country music plus you are a wife and mom to two very athletic teens. How are you able to balance the demands of your job with those at home?

Very little sleep. Ha! I am fortunate enough to be surrounded by amazing people – my family and my co-workers (who are like family). Knowing when to say 'yes' is important, but even more important is knowing when to say 'no.' Early on in my career I felt the need to be everywhere all of the time and I never felt good enough for anyone. I watched as my counter-parts traveled, attended shows and bonded – all while I was home rocking a baby to sleep. It was hard. But I knew what I wanted out of my career and the lifestyle I wanted for my family...and I knew I could have both. It started with me forcing myself to stop feeling guilty. There's always this nagging feeling that I'm never 100% present in anything I'm doing. But the ability to multi-task is a gift and sacrifice is inevitable. I'm not able to attend every school function and I'm not able to attend every artist appearance. But learning to recognize which things really matter and those that are "can't miss" events, has helped immensely. My work family understands my commitment and my kids are well-adjusted. I'm very lucky!

You've been a big part of the development of some amazing music careers through your years at Warner. Is there one that stands out as the most memorable?

Every artist development story is unique and fulfilling in it's own way and it's hard to pick just one. But the one that stands out as the most memorable is being a part of Blake Shelton's career since nearly the very beginning. He and I were both kids, growing up in this business together. To see him evolve from being a hit-or-miss country singer, to one of the biggest superstars in the country format to a household name in American pop culture is truly incredible. It's humbling to think I've been a part of that story.

The world of music promotion has changed quite a bit just in the past five years. What do you now see as the crucial steps to taking a song to the top?

Understanding what drives our fans has never been more important and thankfully we know more about the audience than ever before. Bringing that story to country radio, in a way that contextualizes the importance of it, is my new day job. Having an understanding of the mechanics behind the chart and the implication of syndication has never been more important. But that said, our format is still fueled by relationships (between radio, records and artists) and I hope we never lose sight of that.

Looking way into the future, let's imagine we are all at your highly attended retirement banquet sponsored by the CRB. You have been asked to say a few words including singling out the five people who have been most instrumental in your success. Who would they be and why?

John Esposito – I owe so much to this man. He came into my life at exactly the right time and he gave me the confidence and opportunities I needed to succeed. I would not be here without him.

Chris Stacey – Chris taught me the art of radio promotion. I was inspired by his energy, his passion for the artists and his drive to succeed.

Gator Michaels – While attending Belmont I was an intern for Gator at Dreamcatcher Entertainment. He and David Haley gave me my first job at Warner and I've been here ever since. Without Gator, I would have never been given my start in the industry.

Bo Williams – My amazing husband. We met just 3 weeks after I moved to Nashville and he's been by my side every step of the way. My success has been built upon the foundation we have at home.

Mom and Dad – They were the first to encourage me. Now that I have children of my own I know the extreme sacrifice they made by helping me follow my dreams.

What the heck does Kristen Williams do to relax (assuming that you do, occasionally)?

The lake is my happy place. Any day on the lake is a good day and it's what relaxes me most. Morning walks, coffee and diet coke fuel me. And an occasional Netflix binge!






ALANA SPRINGSTEEN - "AMEN"
