



MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

It's all "Barbie" all the time with three songs from the soundtrack now in the top 10 on the Powers chart. The powerful pivotal song from the movie, "What Was I Made For?" from Billie Eilish, makes it up to number 7 this week up 2 from last week. Top 8 sales and streaming, 7th in callout and the panel is warming up to it with the airplay moving from 23 to 20. Biggest song from the biggest movie. What should one do?

Sticking at the number 3 spot is Dua Lipa's "Dance the Night" also top 10 sales and streaming and callout is picking up with her now in the top 15. It's the 3rd most played song so there's no issue at the radio station level right now. Holding in the second spot is "Barbie World" from Nicki Minaj and newbie Ice Spice, with some help from Aqua. Top 10 sales, top 5 streams and callout and airplay has now entered the top 10 this week at number 9. Three hits right there!


The fastest mover of the week, again, is Doja Cat's "Paint the Town Red" infiltrating the top 10 going from 14th to 8th after only 4 weeks of chart life. She's top 5 sales and streaming but just starting to make some noise at callout at number 19. Stations recognize that this is a quick reaction song as airplay jumps from 19 to 15. This one will go up and down quickly.

Young star Olivia Rodrigo has the distinction of being the only artist with two songs in the top 20 again this week. Her catchy "bad idea, right?" moves up three spots to number 17 overall on the strength of sales (top 12) and streaming (top 10). Stations see the value in this one already with airplay rank up to number 22 from 27 last week. Meanwhile, her haunting ballad "Vampire" rises one spot to number 4 with strong numbers in sales and streaming plus 2nd overall in airplay. Callout is just beginning to pick up at 18 this week. It's definitely a hit but I would keep an eye on the callout because this may start to burn.

Luke Combs'"Fast Car" is stalled at 6 because of the strength of the top 5. Top 5 sales and streaming and top 10 in callout, this is a power for a decent amount of the panel with the song up to 7th in airplay this week.

The other two top 5 tunes have been there a while. Rema and Selena Gomez' "Calm Down" drops one spot from 4 to 5 but remains top 10 in sales, streaming and callout plus stations are hanging in there, too, as it's the 4th most played of the week. All this is happening after 42 weeks on the chart!

Resting comfortably at number one for the third straight week is Taylor Swift's "Cruel Summer". This one is proving it's the summer hit of 2023 with top sales, streaming and callout plus being the most played song again this week.

THE CALLOUT *DIAGNOSIS* HOTAC

Summer is over. Maybe not officially, but life has resumed from summer break and that impacts the lifestyle of the Hot AC listener. Everyone needs a pick-me-up. Freshening your music prior to the fall rating sweep matches the new attitude as we enter a post-summer world. Familiarity builds time spent listening. Fresh new songs builds frequent repeat listening. MMI's research has come through with some definite titles for consideration.

Cupid, by the Korean girl band Fifty Fifty is one that's attracting a lot of attention and could rival the success of the K-Pop phenomena named BTS. The song is new making the familiarity score low for the song, but it still posted 77.6% Familiar. Also showing strong potential is They Kelly Clarkson with "Mine", Harry Styles has "Satellite", "Runaway" OneRepublic is back. "Vampire" by Olivia Rodrigo, Maroon 5's song "Middle Ground" and Lauren Daigle's tune "Thank God I Do." Positive test scores are showing for "Sail Away" Lovely the Band, "Mona Lisa" by Dominic Fike and "Padam-Padam" by Kylie Minogue.

The best testing titles are those that likely reside in the Recurrent category. Creepin', Flowers, Unstoppable, Heat Waves, Stay, Last Night, I'm Good (Blue), Bad Habits, Ghost and Fast Car are the titles that make up the Top-10 best researching titles. "Last Night" by Morgan Wallen is 89.2% Familiar and comes in as the #6 best testing song with the Hot AC panel. It's #13 in the Northeast, #1 in the Midwest, #1 in the South and #10 in the West.

Miley Cyrus' song "Jaded" is in the middle of the test at #28. This is one to watch for it to be replaced as "Used to Be Young" comes into the test group in the coming weeks. "Jaded" is a song that I expected to test better than it has to date. Still has strength, but it doesn't have the same story as the title on the horizon. The question remains as to the possible successor to "Flowers" by Miley. It is researching as the #2 best song Nationally. It's 96.7% Familiar. The Total Positive score is 65.0%. It is a joy to have this artist back on the radio with original songs versus covers on YouTube.

David Guetta Featuring Anne-Marie and Coi Leray with "Baby Don't Hurt Me" is building with young females 25-32. It is actually performing better with females 33-39. Low burn. Clearly testing better on the upper end of the sample because of the songs familiarity. Remakes tend to do that. Whenever considering a remake, I look for what it is that makes the song unique. This one is mixed as if it was produced for a club but is at the length radio seems to like. Similarly "Fast Car" by Luke Combs is a remake that is unique. It is sung by a male, but is from a female perspective. Combs changed nothing in the lyrics. This is likely what it continues to test as a Power category current.



CHARTS/POWERS:

HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.

NOTE: Hot AC Callout information is provided as stand-alone information. This data does not factor into the main chart rankings in any way.
