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# MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

The pop princesses are back, just when the format needs them the most. Miley Cyrus and Selena Gomez join Dua Lipa, Olivia Rodrigo and Taylor Swift on the Powers chart this week. Miley, whose "Jaded" is heading down the chart, comes roaring back to debut at number 10 with her autobiographical tune "Used To Be Young". The song is the number one seller, 5th in audio streams and already at number 21 in callout. Stations have already recognized its potential reaching 17th in airplay. This could be a huge one for her. Meanwhile, Ms. Gomez goes solo and shows up in her first week on this chart at number 15 already with the right-down-the-middle "Single Soon". Lots of tempo and lots of sales already ranked 2nd in that category plus 11th in audio streams. Callout is just starting but the panel is all in with airplay right behind Miley at number 18. Selena's "other" tune – her collab with Rema "Calm Down" – stays in the 5th slot this week. Still strong after 43 chart weeks, it's 7th in callout and 5th in airplay.

Olivia Rodrigo is back again with two songs in the top 20. Her newest "bad idea, right?" sits at number 20 behind top 5 streaming. It's too early for callout but not too early for stations as airplay is up to the 21st spot this week. The song "Vampire" appears to be her next Mediabase number one by the weekend. On the Powers chart, the tune is still strong at number 6 with top 10 streams and, most of all, number one in airplay this week.

Dua Lipa's "Barbie" offering, "Dance The Night", hangs at the number 3 spot again this week with top 10 sales and audio streams, 2nd in video streaming plus 15th in callout. All this has been good enough for the song to be the 2nd most played this week.

Finally, there's Taylor with two in the top 15. "Karma" continues to hang on although it drops a few more spots to 17th but "Cruel Summer", once again, holds on to number one for the third straight week. Top 10 sales and top 5 streaming and callout along with the 3rd most played song on the 50 surveyed, don't let the double-figure callout burn score scare you right now. There you have your nucleus for top 40 moving ahead. A definite positive sign.

The hottest song of the past 4 weeks continues its blazing run to the top. Female rapper Doja Cat's "Paint The Town Red" is the newest entry into the top 5 rising 4 spots to number 4 overall. 3rd in sales, 4th with video streams and number one audio streaming, the tune is catching on with callout at number 12 this week and airplay has grown to a solid number 14.

The "Barbie" movement hasn't stopped, by the way, with two others in the top 10. Billie Eilish's powerful "What Was I Made For?" is at number 9 with top 10 streams and top 5 callout. Airplay is still lagging at 23rd with the tempo and mood of the song most likely being the issue for higher rotation play. Nicki Minaj and Ice Spice (with Aqua) and "Barbie World" remains in the second spot on the chart. Callout is strong ranking 2nd and it's the number one video streamer plus 8th in audio streams. The panel sees the value of the song more each week with airplay up to number 6.

# THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

This week's research shows the stability one expects to see in this format, but it also shows some songs that can be used to freshen your current categories. The Top-10 on the National tab remain mostly unchanged with "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin sitting at #1. The rest of the Top-10 include "Unstoppable" by Sia, "Heatwaves by Glass Animals", Miley Cyrus' song "Flowers", Ed Sheeran with "Bad Habits", "Stay" by The Kid Laroï and Justin Bieber, Morgan Wallen "Last Night", Ed Sheeran doubling up on the chart with "Shivers", likewise for Justin Bieber with "Ghost" and at #10 it's "I'm Good (Blue)" by David Guetta and Bebe Rexha.

Jelly Roll's song "Need a Favor" is for real. The tune is testing at Top-40 and Hot AC. It's already seen a strong ride in MMI's Country research, which has given the tune a high familiarity score of 89% at Hot AC. It's testing slightly better with the younger side of the sample. The overall National score puts it in a Secondary current category while it tests Power in the Midwest and South. The only region where it's showing "Okay" scores is in the West. Even there it tests strong enough to be a Secondary category current. The uniqueness of this song, and the singer's voice, is driving its' popularity.

Only two titles are showing significant enough burn to consider slowing them down. Harry Styles has the most crispy song this week with "As It Was" at 16.9% and Miley's song "Flowers" has a burn score of 16.3%. Neither is fried. Just showing some burn on the fringes which warrants the titles being moved to Recurrent, if not already there. "Unstoppable" by Sia has been researching Power for over a year. The song is only at 13.9% overall Burn. It's Unbelievable that Unstoppable continues to do so well. Biggest radio hit of her career. Newer titles worth a look-see this week include "Single Soon" by Selena Gomez, Jung Kook f/Latto has "Seven" starting to build familiarity and positives, Shinedown with "A Symptom of Being Human" and Dominic Fike with "Mona Lisa." These titles are still starting to build momentum but show real promise. Lauren Daigle, having seen great success at the CCM format, is showing promise with "Thank God I Do." Given the success of Sia, another mature artist with music that's growing an audience is Kylie Minogue. Her song "Padam Padam" is only at 65% Familiar but is showing a positive acceptance making it worthy of consideration for a Tertiary current category.

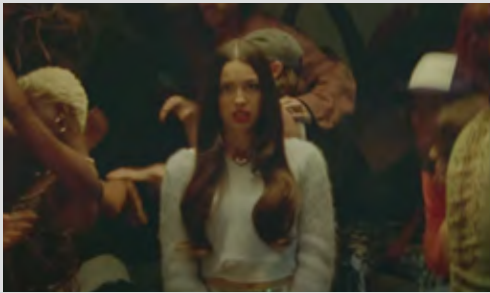
# TAY-TAY UPENDS SPIDEY AND MAY BE SAVING THE THEATER BUSINESS, TOO!

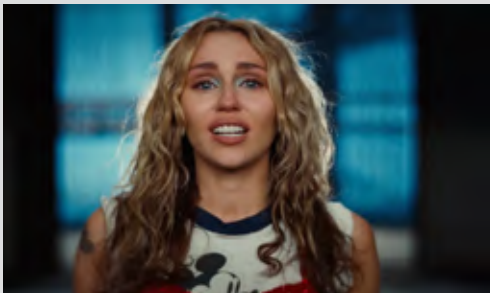

## CHARTS/POWERS:

**1 AIRPLAY** is calculated by Trailing 14 Days of radio airplay on the Key Influencer radio stations – Top 157 radio stations by Average Quarter Hour. Charts are weighted using currently assigned points in Mediabase...100% point value for Morning Drive, 90% for Afternoon Drive, 80% for Mid-days, 70% for nights, 50% for Overnights.

**2 AIRSCORE: THE AIRPLAY INTEL 3.0 RETENTION SCORE** predicts listener tune-in/ tune-out on song play by contemplating the trend over time relationship between local and national airplay, local/regional callout, and audio and video streaming.

**3 NATIONAL CALLOUT** contemplates more than 1,000 respondents weekly in four regions geographically equivalent over the trailing 14 days of calls.

**4 STREAMING, AUDIO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

**5 STREAMING, VIDEO** contemplates trailing 14 days of all streaming. Songs with insufficient data are designated with an "x". These songs do not affect the Total Performance Score in any way.

**6 SALES** is base on 14 days trailing results. Songs with insufficient data are designated as PENDING. Pending songs do not affect Total Performance Score in any way.

## HOT ZONE / DEVELOPING

All five components listed above are contemplated. Songs moving up and increasing significantly in TWO or more categories are designated in the Hot Zone. Other new releases are designated as Developing.

## RECURRENTS

Recurrents are a simple calculation of songs that have trended downward and no longer qualify for Current status. Trailing 14 days are contemplated, along with 6 weeks of Retention Data, and are computed on a 50/50 level of importance.

## ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

## STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
