

MMI WEEK AT A GLANCE

Last week, we were cheering the fact that the ladies of Top 40 pop were starting to take over. Let's add one more unlikely pop-sounding song to the mix from a female RAP superstar. Already in the top 5 with "Barbie World", her collaboration with VMA New Artist winner, Ice Spice, Nicki Minaj has the highest debut of the week at number 22 with the very melodic "Last Time I Saw You". The song is about 10% rap and 90% Nicki's vocals, and she really pulls it off. It's already the number one seller plus 10th in audio streams. Some early panel believers get the song an airplay rank of 38. By the way, the "Barbie World" tune is still in the top 5 dropping two to 4th overall but is still a giant with streaming and callout and now it's top 5 with airplay ranking 5th in that category. Ms. Minaj may have a hot fall.

A second lady of rap rises to the number two spot overall from 4th. Doja Cat's highly reactive "Paint the Town Red" is the number one streaming song this week, 2nd in sales and 6th in callout. Airplay is approaching the power rotation level moving up in rank from 14th to 11th. No question this is big.

The other ladies stay consistent starting with Olivia Rodrigo and two songs still in the top 20 from her just-released "Guts" album. Her former number one "Vampire" stays at number 6 overall on the Powers chart and sitting at 5th in streaming. Airplay is still strong at number 3. Her latest single "bad idea, right?" remains in the 20th spot ranking top 15 in streams just entering the top 20 in airplay at number 18. Selena Gomez also has two songs in the top 20. Her collab with Rema "Calm Down", after 44 weeks on the chart, is still in the Powers top 10 at 7th. Airplay and callout are keeping this alive both at number 7 this week. Meanwhile, her latest release "Single Soon" after a big debut last week drops three spots to number 18 ranking top 20 in sales and streams and up to 14th in airplay marking it as a solid medium rotation tune.


Miley Cyrus' "Used to Be Young" stays at number 10 after her amazing chart debut last week. The song is the 3rd top seller, 11th in audio streams and up 4 spots to 13 with airplay. The panel is taking this home quickly.

Our VMA 8-time winner, Taylor Swift, also has two in the top 20. Her previous number one "Karma" is up one to 16th based on strong callout (11th) and airplay (15th). The crowned "hit of summer 2023", the aptly titled "Cruel Summer", remains in the top spot again this week rising to 6th in sales, 3rd in audio streams and 3rd in callout. In addition, it's the second most played song of the 50 surveyed.

There's a new entry into the top 5, after 19 weeks, country crossover hit "Fast Car" from Luke Combs goes 7 to 5 this week. 4th in sales and streaming and 8th in callout, the last holdouts are in and playing this one often with an airplay rank of 6th. Luke Combs a top 40 hitmaker. Who knew?

Finally, the two other "Barbie" soundtrack hits continue to flourish. Billie Eilish's "What Was I Made For?" sticks in the 9th spot with top 10 sales and streams and top 5 callout. Airplay still lags at 23rd or this song would be higher. The listeners have given the thumbs up. Now it's time for the panel to do the same.

Dua Lipa's "Dance the Night" remains at 3rd overall with strong across the board numbers including being the most played song of the week.

THE CALLOUT DIAGNOSIS HOTAC

The fall survey has begun. The time to freshen your currents and re-sort your library is now. Remember that the fall sweep ends in early December. Once you hit Thanksgiving, many stations start to filter in Christmas music, or they switch to 100% Christmas music. Meaning that you may find yourself with a few crispy tunes on your playlist if you don't start looking ahead now. It also means pushing some of the Power Currents off to Recurrent to open up your rotations.

The Weeknd "Die for You" has a 50+% Positive score. It looks to be headed for Top-10 researching at the Hot AC Format. Seeing early research on early songs "Single Soon" by Selena Gomez, Jung Kook f/Latto with "Seven", Shinedown with "A Symptom of Being Human" and Dominic Fike with "Mona Lisa." These titles are still new and lack familiarity, but they show potential.

Lauren Daigle, having seen great success at the CCM format, is garnering attention with "Thank God I Do." It's nowhere near a Power category with only a 40% Positive score, but it is 75.6% Familiar. Market after-market I see strong ratings for stations that play her music. When is the last time anyone played a current from Kylie Minogue? "Padam Padam" is slowly gaining familiarity and continues to show positives making it worthy of a listen and consideration. Tertiary would be the right category for it based on this weeks research.


The "Biggies" on the National tab continues to include "Creepin'" by Metro Boomin, "Unstoppable" by Sia, "Heatwaves by Glass Animals", Miley Cyrus with "Flowers", Ed Sheeran's song "Bad Habits" and "Shivers", "Stay" by The Kid Laroi and Justin Bieber, "Last Night" by the newly head shaved Morgan Wallen, Justin Bieber has "Ghost" testing well and "I'm Good (Blue)" by David Guetta and Bebe Rexha just won't stop testing as a Power song.

Note that Jelly Roll's song "Need a Favor" is shaking up the music world. A song, and artist like Jelly Roll, wasn't expected to become a Country hit, let alone crossover to CHR and now Hot AC. It's a genuine hit and testing very well with its' biggest scores coming in the Midwest and South. I'm not sure if it's the singer's voice that makes this song so memorable or if it's the lyrics and the story itself. It is certainly a familiar situation that is supported by the experiences of many. Thus, a strong test score for Jelly Roll. Let the survey begin.





ACTION

Songs that are testing either in Callout or in Retention significantly higher than current Airplay rank. These songs are considered UNDEREXPOSED and deserving generally of greater airplay.

STREAMING AUDIO, VIDEO AND SALES

Streaming Audio and Video, and Sales, are based on trailing 14 days data. All major streaming services are used wherever possible, along with sales.
